Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Ahmedabad

- Arrive in Ahmedabad and transfer to your hotel for check-in.
- Visit the Sabarmati Ashram, the former residence of Mahatma Gandhi, which now serves as a museum showcasing his life and teachings. The ashram includes Gandhi's living quarters and various exhibits on his philosophy and role in the Indian independence movement.
- Explore the Sidi Saiyyed Mosque, famous for its intricate stone latticework, particularly the Tree of Life window, which is an iconic symbol of Ahmedabad's architectural heritage.

- Visit the Akshardham Temple, a magnificent Hindu temple complex dedicated to Swaminarayan, known for its stunning architecture and spiritual ambiance. The complex also includes an informative exhibition on Indian culture and values.

- Explore the Calico Museum of Textiles, one of the finest textile museums in the world, showcasing a remarkable collection of fabrics and artifacts from various regions of India, including rare and antique textiles.
- Visit the Bhadra Fort and Teen Darwaza, historical landmarks of Ahmedabad known for their impressive architecture and historical significance. The Bhadra Fort complex includes a palace, a mosque, and an open space used for public gatherings.
- Stroll through the Manek Chowk market, a bustling market area known for its jewelry, food stalls, and vibrant atmosphere. In the evening, the market transforms into a foodie's paradise with a variety of street food options.
- Visit the Hutheesing Jain Temple, an exquisite temple built in the 19th century, renowned for its intricate carvings and architectural elegance.

Day 3: Ahmedabad - Udaipur (260kms)

- After breakfast at the hotel, drive to Udaipur, a journey of approximately 5-6 hours.
- En route, visit the Modhera Sun Temple, an ancient temple dedicated to the Sun God, known for its beautiful architecture and elaborate carvings.
- Continue to Udaipur and check-in at the hotel.
- In the evening, enjoy a boat ride on Lake Pichola, offering picturesque views of the City Palace, Jag Mandir, and the surrounding hills. The lake is especially enchanting at sunset when the palaces and ghats are beautifully illuminated.

Day 4: Udaipur

- Start the day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit the City Palace, an exquisite palace complex with a rich history, stunning architecture, and a museum showcasing royal artifacts. The palace offers panoramic views of the city and Lake Pichola from its balconies and towers.
- Explore the Jagdish Temple, a major Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu, known for its intricate carvings and architectural beauty. The temple is a prominent landmark in Udaipur and a center of spiritual activity.
- Visit Saheliyon Ki Bari, a beautiful garden adorned with fountains, lotus pools, and marble pavilions, once a recreational area for royal ladies. The garden is a serene retreat with its lush greenery and soothing ambiance.
- Explore the Bagore Ki Haveli, an old haveli converted into a museum, offering insights into the royal lifestyle and cultural heritage of Rajasthan. The haveli features numerous rooms decorated with period furniture, costumes, and artworks.
- Enjoy the evening at the Fateh Sagar Lake, a serene lake offering boating opportunities and stunning sunset views. The lake is surrounded by hills and features three islands, including the Nehru Park, which has a boat-shaped restaurant and a small zoo.
- Attend the Dharohar Dance Show at Bagore Ki Haveli in the evening to witness traditional Rajasthani dance and music performances.

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Day 5: Udaipur - Ahmedabad (260kms)

- After breakfast at the hotel, drive back to Ahmedabad, a journey of approximately 5-6 hours.
- En route, visit the famous Shamlaji Temple, an ancient Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu, known for its architectural beauty and religious significance. The temple is an important pilgrimage site and features intricate carvings and sculptures.
- Continue to Ahmedabad and, if time permits, visit the Sarkhej Roza, an architectural complex with tombs, palaces, and mosques, reflecting a blend of Islamic and Hindu architectural styles.
- Arrive in Ahmedabad and transfer to the airport or railway station for your onward journey, concluding the Ahmedabad & Udaipur City Break.
