- Explore Sayaji Gardens, a well-maintained park offering a serene environment for relaxation.
- Continue to Champaner-Pavagadh Archaeological Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its medieval monuments and ancient ruins.
- Upon reaching Kevadia, immerse yourself in the mesmerizing Light & Sound show at the Statue of Unity, an awe-inspiring monument dedicated to Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel.

Day 4: Kevadia - Maheshwar (265kms)

- Begin your day with breakfast at the hotel before visiting the Statue of Unity, the world's tallest statue, symbolizing unity and strength.
- Explore the surrounding complex, including the scenic Valley of Flowers, the insightful Museum detailing Sardar Patel's life, and the impressive Sardar Sarovar Dam.
- Afterward, drive to Maheshwar and check in to your hotel.
- Visit the grand Maheshwar Fort, overlooking the Narmada River, and explore its majestic architecture and panoramic views of the river.
- Stroll along the Maheshwar Ghats, known for their serene atmosphere and historic significance.

Day 5: Maheshwar - Mandu Day Trip

- Take a dip in the holy river before entering the temple premises for a spiritual experience.
- Continue your journey to Indore and check in to your hotel.
- Visit the Lal Bagh Palace Museum, renowned for its regal architecture, exquisite artifacts, and lush gardens reflecting the grandeur of a bygone era.
- Explore the local markets of Indore for a taste of the city's vibrant culture and cuisine.

Day 7: Indore - Ujjain - Departure
