Your adventure culminates with excursions to Gondal's regal Navlakha Palace and Junagadh's historic sites, blending heritage and natural beauty into an unforgettable experience.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Ahmedabad

- Upon arrival at Ahmedabad airport, you will be met by our representative and assisted with your transfer to the hotel.
- Check in to your hotel and take time to relax and unwind from your journey.

Day 2: Ahmedabad City Tour

- Start your day with breakfast at the hotel before embarking on a city tour of Ahmedabad.
- Visit Sabarmati Ashram, Mahatma Gandhi's residence, where you can see exhibits related to his life and the Indian independence movement.
- Explore Sidi Saiyyed Mosque, renowned for its exquisite latticework of the "Tree of Life" in the windows.
- Discover Jama Masjid, one of the largest mosques in India, featuring grand arches, intricately carved pillars, and a serene courtyard.
- Visit the Adalaj Stepwell, an architectural marvel with five stories of ornate carvings and cooling chambers, designed to provide water in the arid climate.
- Experience the Swaminarayan Temple in Kalupur, known for its beautifully detailed marble carvings and vibrant colors, offering a peaceful spiritual retreat.
- Explore the Calico Museum of Textiles, showcasing a vast collection of antique textiles and traditional Indian fabrics, reflecting the rich weaving heritage of the region.

Day 3: Ahmedabad - Dasada (260kms)

- Begin with breakfast at the hotel before driving to Dasada.
- En route, visit Modhera Sun Temple, a 11th-century temple dedicated to the Sun God, renowned for its beautifully carved pillars and intricate sculptures depicting various deities and mythical scenes.
- Explore Rani ki Vav, a UNESCO World Heritage site, celebrated for its elaborately carved stepwell with detailed sculptures of gods, goddesses, and mythical creatures.
- Continue your drive to Dasada and check in at your hotel.
- In the evening, visit the Little Rann of Kutch and enjoy a camel safari to explore the landscape and spot various wildlife, including wild asses and migratory birds.
- Enjoy a leisurely walk around the village, observing local crafts and interacting with residents to experience traditional rural life.

Day 4: Dasada - Rajkot (160kms)

- After breakfast, start your day with an early morning safari in the Little Rann of Kutch.
- Witness the endangered Indian wild asses and various bird species in this unique salt marsh ecosystem, ideal for birdwatching and wildlife photography.
- Return to the hotel for breakfast before heading to Rajkot.
- Upon arrival in Rajkot, check in at your hotel and freshen up.
- Visit Watson Museum, featuring exhibits on the region's history, including artifacts from the colonial era and ancient manuscripts.
- Explore Kaba Gandhi No Delo, the childhood residence of Mahatma Gandhi, with displays on his formative years and early influences.
- Visit the Rotary Dolls Museum, which houses an extensive collection of dolls from around the world, providing insight into global cultures and traditions.
- Stroll through Jubilee Garden, known for its well-maintained greenery, historical statues, and a peaceful environment perfect for relaxation.

Day 5: Rajkot - Gondal - Junagadh - Rajkot (200kms round) / Departure

- Start with breakfast at the hotel before departing for an excursion to Gondal.
- Visit Navlakha Palace, an opulent 19th-century palace featuring intricate carvings, antique furnishings, and a glimpse into the royal lifestyle of the Jadeja Rajput clan.
- Explore the Vintage Car Museum in Gondal, showcasing a collection of classic automobiles including Rolls-Royces and Cadillacs, highlighting the era's luxury and style.
- Proceed to Junagadh and visit Mohabbat Maqbara, a mausoleum famous for its unique architecture combining elements of both Islamic and European styles, set amidst beautifully landscaped gardens.
- Explore Uparkot Fort, a historic fort complex with impressive ramparts, ancient caves, and a stepwell, offering panoramic views of the city.
- Return to Rajkot for your transfer to the airport for your departure flight.
