Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Amritsar

Day 2: Amritsar - Dalhousie (200kms)

- Explore the Durgiana Temple, often referred to as the "Silver Temple" for its striking resemblance to the Golden Temple and dedicated to Goddess Durga. Admire its intricate marble work and serene ambiance.
- Visit the historic Govindgarh Fort, a symbol of Amritsar's military past offering panoramic views of the cityscape from its ramparts. Learn about its role in local history and enjoy the peaceful surroundings.
- Later, embark on a picturesque drive to Dalhousie, a charming hill station nestled amidst the verdant Dhauladhar range.
- Journey through winding mountain roads, passing quaint villages and terraced fields, with vistas of snow-capped peaks in the distance.

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- Upon arrival in Dalhousie, check-in at your hotel and savor the crisp mountain air and panoramic views that surround you. - Conclude your tour with a visit to the Partition Museum, housed in Amritsar's historic Town Hall. Explore the exhibits and personal stories documenting the Partition of India in 1947, offering insights into this pivotal moment in history.
- Depart from Amritsar with cherished memories of your enriching journey through Punjab's cultural heritage, the spiritual aura of Amritsar, and the serene beauty of the Himalayan foothills.
