Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Dibrugarh

- Depart for Itanagar, enjoying the scenic drive through lush landscapes and picturesque spots for photo opportunities.

Day 3: Itanagar

Day 4: Itanagar - Kaziranga National Park (200kms)

- Stop at Tezpur and explore its cultural landmarks, including the ancient Agnigarh Fort, perched atop a hill with panoramic views of the Brahmaputra River.
- Visit Bamuni Hills, known for its ancient sculptures and ruins dating back centuries, offering a glimpse into historical artistry.

- Continue to the historic town of Sadiya and explore the beautiful Sadiya Fort, known for its unique architecture and historical significance.
- Arrive in Kaziranga, check in at your hotel, and enjoy a relaxed evening. Visit the Kaziranga National Orchid Park to explore a diverse collection of orchids native to the region.

Day 5: Kaziranga National Park
