Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Ahmedabad

- On arrival at Ahmedabad airport, you will be warmly welcomed and transferred to your hotel.

Day 2: Ahmedabad - Bhavnagar (175kms)

- Continue to Bhavnagar and check in at your hotel.
- After freshening up, visit Takhteshwar Temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva, offering panoramic views of Bhavnagar city.
- Explore Nilambag Palace, a 19th-century palace now transformed into a heritage hotel, showcasing Rajput architecture and royal history.

- Spend your evening strolling through local markets such as Bengali Bazaar for local handicrafts and regional cuisine.

Day 3: Bhavnagar - Sasan Gir NP (225kms)

- Begin your day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Drive to Sasan Gir National Park, the abode of the Asiatic Lion.
- Check in at your hotel upon arrival and relax.
- In the afternoon, embark on an exciting safari in the national park, observing diverse wildlife including lions, leopards, deer, and gazelles.
- Return to your hotel in the evening and unwind.
- Optionally, explore nearby villages like Sasan Gir Village to experience local culture and traditional lifestyle.

Day 4: Sasan Gir

- Start with breakfast at the hotel.
- Head out for an early morning safari, the best time to observe the park's wildlife in their most active state, including Asiatic lions, leopards, and various bird species.
- Return to the hotel for a relaxing break, enjoying the serene surroundings and wildlife sounds.
- After lunch, embark on a late afternoon safari, capturing the changing light and possibly spotting elusive animals such as the Indian fox or the sambar deer.

Day 5: Sasan Gir - Rajkot (160kms)

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel.
- Drive to Rajkot, known for its historical and cultural significance.
- Check in at your hotel upon arrival and freshen up.
- Visit the Watson Museum, featuring exhibits on the history, culture, and art of the Saurashtra region, including fossils and manuscripts.
- Explore Kaba Gandhi No Delo, Mahatma Gandhi's childhood home, preserved as a museum showcasing his early life and personal belongings.
- Visit Aaji Dam, a picturesque reservoir offering a serene environment for relaxation and birdwatching.
- Discover the Rotary Dolls Museum, with a collection of dolls from various countries reflecting different cultures and traditions.
- Spend your evening exploring Rajkot's local markets for handicrafts, textiles, and local cuisine.

Day 6: Rajkot - Ahmedabad (225kms)

- Travel back to Ahmedabad.
