Day 1: Arrive Delhi

Day 5: Jaipur

- Explore Kirti Stambh (Tower of Fame), another impressive tower known for its intricate carvings and architectural splendor.

- Visit Jain temples within the fort complex, known for their exquisite marble carvings and religious significance.
- Rest of the day is free for relaxation.
- Overnight at homestay.

Day 10: Chittorgarh - Udaipur (120 kms)

- Explore Shilpgram, a rural arts and crafts complex showcasing traditional Rajasthani arts and culture.
- Visit Hathi Pol Bazar for shopping and exploring local handicrafts.
- Enjoy a boat ride on Lake Pichola, exploring its serene waters and visiting the iconic Jag Mandir Palace located on an island in the lake.
- In the evening, watch the Dharohar folk dance show at Bagore-ki-Haveli, showcasing vibrant Rajasthani folk dances and music.
- Overnight at homestay.

Day 11: Udaipur - Dungarpur (120 kms)

- After breakfast at the hotel, drive to Dungarpur.

- Check-in at the hotel upon arrival.
- Visit Udai Bilas Palace, an opulent palace turned heritage hotel known for its Rajput architecture and picturesque setting.

- Visit Adalaj Step-well, an ancient stepwell known for its intricate carvings, architectural beauty, and historical significance.
- Overnight at homestay.
