Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Delhi

- Upon arrival at Delhi airport, you will be greeted by our representative who will assist you with the transfer to your hotel.
- Take some time to relax and engage in personal activities, acclimating to your surroundings.

Day 2: Delhi

- Start your day with breakfast at the hotel before embarking on a comprehensive city tour of both Old and New Delhi.
- Visit Jama Masjid, one of the largest mosques in India, renowned for its grand architecture and historical significance. Marvel at its vast courtyard and intricate carvings.

- Explore the grand government buildings including the President's House and Parliament House, reflecting the British colonial architectural style.
- Wander through Chandni Chowk, a historic market area known for its vibrant local culture, narrow lanes, and street food delicacies.

Day 3: Delhi - Agra (210 km)

Day 6: Khajuraho - Bhopal (375 km)
