Witness majestic tigers and other wildlife against the backdrop of the Kosi River before concluding this holistic journey back in Delhi.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Delhi - Haridwar/ Rishikesh (220km)

- Depart from Delhi in the morning and drive to Haridwar/Rishikesh, located at the foothills of the Himalayas.
- Upon arrival in Haridwar, visit Har Ki Pauri, one of the holiest ghats on the banks of the Ganges River. Experience the evening Ganga Aarti, a mesmerizing ritual of lights and chanting prayers.

Day 2: Haridwar/ Rishikesh

- Enjoy a refreshing breakfast at your hotel.
- Explore Rishikesh, known as the "Yoga Capital of the World". Visit Parmarth Niketan Ashram, offering yoga and meditation classes in a serene setting by the Ganges.
- Cross the iconic suspension bridges, Ram Jhula and Laxman Jhula, for panoramic views of the river and hills.
- Visit the Beatles Ashram (Maharishi Mahesh Yogi Ashram), known for its association with The Beatles during their stay in the 1960s. Explore the graffiti-covered walls and meditation cells.
- Explore Kankhal in old Haridwar, known for its ancient temples and cultural heritage sites.

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- Visit Sivananda Ashram, a spiritual retreat known for yoga and meditation sessions amidst peaceful surroundings.
- Visit Triveni Ghat for a holy dip in the Ganges and witness the evening Aarti ceremony, a spiritual experience by the riverside.

Day 3: Haridwar/ Rishikesh - Corbett Tiger Reserve (225kms)

- After breakfast, depart for Jim Corbett National Park, India's oldest tiger reserve.
- En route, visit the Garjiya Devi Temple, located on the banks of the Kosi River, offering panoramic views of the park and its surroundings.

Day 4: Corbett Tiger Reserve

- Start early with a morning jungle safari in an open jeep, guided by expert naturalists. Explore the diverse wildlife of Corbett Tiger Reserve, including tigers, elephants, deer, and various bird species.
- Return to the resort for breakfast and relax.
- In the afternoon, enjoy another thrilling jungle safari to different zones of the park, increasing your chances of wildlife sightings.
- Optional activities include a nature walk along the Kosi River or birdwatching sessions to observe the rich avian diversity.

Day 5: Corbett Tiger Reserve - Delhi (260kms)

- Enjoy breakfast at the resort.
- Embark on a final afternoon jungle safari to explore more of Corbett's wilderness.
- Depart for Delhi after lunch, enjoying scenic views and stopping at local eateries en route.
- Arrive in Delhi by late afternoon, where the tour concludes with drop-off at your preferred location.
