Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive in Delhi

- Upon arrival at Delhi airport, our representative will greet you and assist with your transfer to the hotel.
- After checking in, relax and acclimate to Delhi's vibrant energy, preparing for your upcoming adventures.

Day 2: Delhi Sightseeing

- Start your day with a hearty breakfast at your hotel.
- In Old Delhi, visit the Red Fort (Lal Qila), a UNESCO World Heritage site with majestic red sandstone walls and historical significance as the Mughal emperors' residence.
- Explore Jama Masjid, India's largest mosque, known for its impressive Mughal architecture and expansive courtyard offering panoramic views of Old Delhi.
- Wander through Chandni Chowk, a bustling market famous for vibrant bazaars, street food stalls, and traditional artisan workshops.
- In New Delhi, admire India Gate, a war memorial dedicated to Indian soldiers, symbolizing national pride and unity.

Day 3: Delhi to Mandawa (250kms/5hrs approx)

- Visit Hanuman Prasad Goenka Haveli, famous for its vibrant frescoes depicting mythological stories and local folklore.
- Explore Murmuria Haveli, known for its unique architecture and intricate frescoes narrating tales of Mandawa's rich heritage.
- Discover other notable havelis like the Goenka Double Haveli, showcasing golden leaf paintings and historical artwork.

Day 4: Mandawa to Jaipur (170kms/3hrs approx)

- Start your day with breakfast at the hotel before setting off for Jaipur, the "Pink City."
- Arrive in Jaipur and check in at your hotel.
- Spend the afternoon exploring Johri Bazaar and Bapu Bazaar, famous for traditional Rajasthani handicrafts, jewelry, textiles, and local sweets.
- Visit the Albert Hall Museum, an Indo-Saracenic building housing an extensive collection of art, artifacts, and antiques.

Day 5: Jaipur Sightseeing

- Begin with breakfast at the hotel before a full day exploring Jaipur's regal heritage.
- Ascend Amber Fort on an elephant back or jeep, exploring its ornate palaces, intricate mirror work, and stunning views of Maota Lake.
- Visit the City Palace, a sprawling royal complex that combines Rajasthani and Mughal architectural styles, featuring ornate courtyards, museums, and artifacts.

- Explore Jantar Mantar, the world's largest stone astronomical observatory, with monumental instruments used for celestial observations.
- Admire Hawa Mahal, the five-story palace with a honeycomb facade designed for royal women to observe street festivities from behind lattice windows.
- Stroll through Sisodia Rani Garden, serene terraced gardens with cascading fountains, lush foliage, and Mughal-style pavilions.
- Visit Birla Temple, a white marble temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu and Goddess Lakshmi, known for its intricate carvings and peaceful ambiance.
- Enjoy more shopping at local markets and emporiums for traditional Rajasthani textiles, handcrafted souvenirs, and exquisite jewelry.

Day 6: Jaipur to Ranthambore (155kms/3hrs approx)

- Have breakfast at the hotel before driving to Ranthambore National Park, renowned for its tiger population.
- Upon arrival, check in at your resort and then visit Ranthambore Fort, a historic hilltop fortress offering panoramic views of the park and steeped in legends of valor and grandeur.

Day 7: Ranthambore Wildlife Safari

- Begin your day with breakfast at the resort.
- Embark on thrilling morning and afternoon game drives through Ranthambore National Park, searching for Bengal tigers and other wildlife like leopards and sloth bears.
- Explore the park's diverse landscapes, including deciduous forests, grasslands, and lakes, while capturing unforgettable moments of Ranthambore's pristine natural beauty.

Day 8: Ranthambore to Kota (190kms/4hrs approx)

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before setting off for Kota, via Bundi.
- Visit Taragarh Fort in Bundi, famous for its panoramic views and historical significance.
- Explore Bundi Palace, noted for its exquisite frescoes and architectural brilliance.
- Continue your journey to Kota, check in at your hotel, and visit City Palace, Jagmandir Palace, and Chambal Gardens, appreciating the city's historical and architectural heritage.

Day 9: Kota to Orchha (330kms/6hrs approx)

- After breakfast, drive to Orchha via Shivpuri.
- Stop at Madhav Palace in Shivpuri, a colonial-era gem surrounded by lush gardens and reflecting pools.
- Continue to Orchha, check in at your hotel, and take a serene evening boat ride on the River Betwa, admiring the stunning views of Orchha Fort and the surrounding landscapes.

Day 10: Orchha Sightseeing - Gwalior (120kms/3hrs approx)

- Start with breakfast at the hotel before exploring Orchha's grand palaces and temples.
- Visit the Orchha Fort complex, including Jahangir Mahal, Raj Mahal, and Chaturbhuj Temple, marveling at their architectural splendor and intricate artwork.
- In the afternoon, drive to Gwalior, check in at your hotel.
- Explore Gwalior Fort, an imposing hilltop fortress blending Hindu and Mughal architecture.
- Visit Man Mandir Palace, Sas Bahu Temple, and Jai Vilas Palace Museum, known for their historical and architectural significance.

Day 11: Gwalior to Agra (120kms/2hrs approx)

- After breakfast, drive to Agra.
- Visit the Taj Mahal, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the Seven Wonders of the World, renowned for its breathtaking beauty and architectural perfection.

- Stroll through Mehtab Bagh for a picturesque view of the Taj Mahal at sunset.
- Enjoy shopping for local handicrafts and souvenirs in Agra.

Day 12: Agra Sightseeing and Departure to Delhi (210kms/4hrs approx)

- Drive back to Delhi after breakfast.
- Transfer to the airport or your desired location for your onward journey.
