Tour Overview

Jaipur beckons with its royal forts, including Amber and Jaigarh, and the ornate City Palace. Conclude in Pushkar, where the tranquil lake and Brahma Temple offer a spiritual retreat amidst ancient legends.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Delhi

- Upon arrival at Delhi airport, you will be greeted and transferred to your hotel (check-in/out time 12 pm). After freshening up, embark on a city tour of Delhi:
- Visit Jama Masjid, one of the largest mosques in the world built by Shah Jahan.
- Enjoy a thrilling cycle rickshaw ride through the bustling streets of Chandni Chowk.
- Experience the aromatic delights of Khari Baoli Spice Market, one of Asia's largest spice markets.
- Pay respects at Raj Ghat, the memorial dedicated to Mahatma Gandhi.
- Visit the Lotus Temple, renowned for its unique lotus-shaped architecture and tranquil atmosphere.
- Drive past prominent landmarks including the President House, Parliament House, and India Gate.
- Overnight at hotel in Delhi.

Day 2: Delhi - Agra (200kms)

- After breakfast, depart for Agra. Check-in at your hotel and then proceed to explore:
- Taj Mahal: Immerse yourself in the splendor of this UNESCO World Heritage site, known for its stunning white marble architecture and intricate craftsmanship.
- Agra Fort: Discover the historical significance of this red sandstone fort, a symbol of power, resilience, and grandeur during the Mughal era.
- Itmad-ud-Daula Tomb: Explore this exquisite marble mausoleum often referred to as the "Baby Taj," commissioned by Nur Jahan in memory of her father.
- Optional: Visit Mehtab Bagh for a picturesque view of the Taj Mahal at sunset.

- Overnight at hotel in Agra.

Day 3: Agra - Jaipur (245kms)

- After breakfast, depart for Jaipur. En route, explore:
- Fatehpur Sikri: Discover this abandoned Mughal city, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its stunning architecture including the Jama Masjid and Buland Darwaza.
- Abhaneri Stepwell: Marvel at India's deepest and largest stepwell, Chand Baori, and visit the adjoining Harshat Mata Temple.
- Upon arrival in Jaipur, check-in at your hotel. Evening free to explore the vibrant markets of Pink City.
- Overnight at hotel in Jaipur.

Day 4: Jaipur

- After breakfast, embark on a full day city tour of Jaipur:
- Amber Fort: Ascend to this hilltop fort on an elephant or Jeep ride and explore its palaces, courtyards, and stunning views of Maota Lake.
- Jaigarh Fort: Visit this impressive fort known for the world's largest cannon on wheels, Jaivana.
- City Palace: Explore the royal residence showcasing a blend of Rajput and Mughal architecture, with museums displaying artifacts of the royal family.
- Jantar Mantar: Discover the ancient astronomical observatory featuring precise instruments used for celestial observations.
- Hawa Mahal: Admire the facade of this iconic "Palace of Winds," designed for the royal ladies to observe street festivities unseen.
- Sisodia Rani Garden: Enjoy the peaceful ambiance of these royal gardens adorned with fountains, pavilions, and murals depicting Radha-Krishna legends.
- Birla Temple: Visit this modern Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu and Goddess Lakshmi, known for its intricate marble carvings.
- Overnight at hotel in Jaipur.

Day 5: Jaipur - Pushkar (145kms)

- After breakfast, drive to Pushkar, a sacred town known for its religious significance and scenic beauty:
- Pushkar Lake: Visit the holy lake surrounded by 52 bathing ghats where devotees perform rituals and ceremonies.
- Brahma Temple: Explore the only temple in the world dedicated to Lord Brahma, the creator of the universe.
- Savitri Temple: Climb the hill for panoramic views of Pushkar and the surrounding desert landscape.
- Khwaja Dargah E Sharif: Optionally visit this revered Sufi shrine in Ajmer.
- Adhai Din Ka Jhonpda: Explore the ancient mosque known for its Indo-Islamic architecture.
- Anasagar Lake: Visit this serene artificial lake built by Anaji Chauhan, surrounded by lush gardens and marble pavilions.

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- Overnight at hotel in Pushkar.

Day 6: Pushkar - Delhi (400kms)

- After breakfast, depart for Delhi. Upon arrival, check-in at your hotel and relax. Evening at leisure to explore local markets or relax at the hotel.
- Overnight at hotel in Delhi.

Day 7: Delhi - Departure

- After breakfast, as per your flight schedule, transfer to the airport for your onward journey.
