Continue your adventure through Rajasthan, visiting historic forts in Jaipur, the lakeside charm of Udaipur, and the cultural richness of Pushkar. This expedition promises a perfect blend of wildlife encounters and cultural immersion, offering an enriching experience of India's diverse heritage and natural wonders.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Delhi

- Arrive in Delhi and transfer to your hotel for check-in.
- Rest and relax after your journey to prepare for the upcoming exploration.

Day 2: Delhi

- After breakfast, start your day with a visit to Old Delhi including the impressive Jama Masjid, India's largest mosque offering stunning views of the city from its minarets.
- Enjoy a thrilling rickshaw ride through the bustling lanes of Chandni Chowk, Delhi's oldest and busiest market, famous for its diverse array of street food and vibrant atmosphere.
- Visit Raj Ghat, the serene memorial of Mahatma Gandhi, where you can pay homage to the Father of the Nation.

Day 3: Delhi - Agra (210kms/ 4hrs approx)

- Visit the Taj Mahal, the iconic symbol of eternal love and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Marvel at its white marble beauty during sunrise or sunset.
- Explore Agra Fort, a UNESCO-listed fort with palaces, mosques, and audience halls exhibiting the grandeur of Mughal architecture.
- Visit Itmad-ud-Daulah's Tomb, also known as the "Baby Taj", an exquisite marble mausoleum reflecting Persian architectural elements.
- Overnight stay in Agra.

Day 4: Agra - Ranthambore (250kms/ 5hrs approx)

- Depart for Ranthambore after breakfast, known for its wildlife sanctuary.
- En route, visit Fatehpur Sikri, a UNESCO World Heritage site and former Mughal capital with well-preserved palaces and courtyards.
- Arrive in Ranthambore and check into your hotel.
- Visit Ranthambore Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage site offering panoramic views and housing ancient temples and reservoirs.
- Overnight stay in Ranthambore.

Day 5: Ranthambore

- Early morning, embark on a thrilling wildlife safari in Ranthambore National Park, renowned for its population of tigers, leopards, sloth bears, and diverse bird species.
- After the safari, return to the hotel for a hearty breakfast and some leisure time to relax and refresh.
- In the afternoon, set out on another safari ride into Ranthambore National Park, exploring different zones for a chance to spot more wildlife and experience the park's natural beauty.
- Enjoy the evening at leisure, perhaps relaxing by the pool or exploring the local surroundings.

- Overnight stay in Ranthambore, immersing yourself in the wilderness and tranquility of this renowned national park.
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Day 6: Ranthambore - Bundi (155kms/ 3hrs approx)

- Depart for Bundi after breakfast.
- Visit Taragarh Fort, the imposing hilltop fort known for its panoramic views and well-preserved structures dating back to the 14th century.
- Explore Bundi Palace, a royal complex featuring the iconic Chitrashala (Painted Gallery) with intricate murals depicting mythological scenes.
- Visit Sukh Mahal, a serene palace by the lake known for its blend of Mughal and Rajput architecture.
- Optional: Visit Jait Sagar Lake for serene boat rides and scenic views.
- Overnight stay in Bundi.

Day 7: Bundi - Pushkar (180kms/ 4hrs approx)

- Depart for Pushkar after breakfast.
- Visit the Brahma Temple, dedicated to Lord Brahma and one of the few temples in the world dedicated to this deity.
- Explore Pushkar Lake, a sacred Hindu pilgrimage site surrounded by 52 ghats where devotees perform rituals and take holy dips.
- Visit Pushkar Bazaar, known for its vibrant handicrafts, clothing, and souvenirs.
- Attend the evening Aarti ceremony at Varaha Ghat for a spiritual experience.
- Overnight stay in Pushkar.

Day 8: Pushkar - Jaipur (145kms/ 3hrs approx)

- Depart for Jaipur after breakfast.
- Visit Nahargarh Fort, offering stunning sunset views over Jaipur city.
- Enjoy shopping at local markets such as Johari Bazaar and Bapu Bazaar for textiles, jewelry, and handicrafts.
- Optional: Visit Albert Hall Museum for a glimpse into Rajasthan's cultural heritage.

- Overnight stay in Jaipur.

Day 9: Jaipur

- After breakfast, Visit the Amber Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its artistic blend of Hindu and Mughal architecture. Enjoy an elephant or jeep ride to reach the fort.
- Explore Jaigarh Fort, renowned for the world's largest cannon on wheels and panoramic views of the Aravalli Hills.
- Visit City Palace, a royal residence with museums showcasing textiles, arms, and artifacts.
- Explore Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds), an iconic five-story palace with intricately designed windows allowing royal ladies to observe street festivals without being seen.
- Visit Jantar Mantar, an astronomical observatory and UNESCO World Heritage site featuring architectural astronomical instruments.
- Attend an evening cultural performance showcasing Rajasthani folk music and dance.

Day 10: Jaipur - Delhi (265kms/ 5hrs approx) / Departure (flight)

- Depart for Delhi after breakfast.
- Transfer to Delhi airport for your onward flight, concluding the memorable Golden Triangle Tour Including Bundi Village & Ranthambore National Park.
