Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Delhi

- Arrive in Delhi and transfer to your hotel.
- Qutub Minar: Marvel at the tallest brick minaret in the world, a UNESCO World Heritage site, known for its Indo-Islamic architecture and intricate carvings. Learn about its historical significance as you explore the surrounding complex.

- Start with breakfast at the hotel.

- Visit Abhaneri, known for the Chand Baori stepwell. Marvel at its intricate architecture and learn about its historical significance as a water source and community gathering place.

Day 4: Jaipur

- Start with breakfast at the hotel.
