Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Guwahati

- Arrive in Guwahati and transfer to your hotel. After settling in, start your exploration of Guwahati.
- Visit Kamakhya Temple, one of the most revered Hindu shrines dedicated to Goddess Kamakhya, known for its architectural grandeur, religious significance, and panoramic views of the Brahmaputra River.
- Explore Assam State Museum, showcasing a rich collection of artifacts, sculptures, and manuscripts depicting Assamese culture and history, including tribal crafts and ancient relics.

- Explore Auniati Satra, renowned for its ancient manuscripts, art collections, and traditional mask-making that reflect Assamese artistry and cultural heritage.
- Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner at Majuli hotel.

Day 5: Majuli - Jorhat (40km) / Departure

- Spend the morning exploring more of Majuli Island, visiting Samaguri Satra to witness the intricate process of mask-making and interact with skilled artisans.
- Return to Jorhat and visit the Tocklai Tea Research Institute, where you can delve into Assam's tea industry, its history, and ongoing research initiatives.
- Conclude your tour with a transfer to Jorhat Airport for your onward journey, reflecting on the cultural and natural wonders of Assam experienced during your trip.
