Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Hubli - Gadag - Lakkundi - Hampi (180kms)

- Pick up from Hubli airport and drive to Hampi.
- En route, visit Gadag and explore the Trikuteshwara Temple, showcasing intricate carvings and early Chalukyan architecture dedicated to Lord Shiva.
- Continue to Lakkundi and visit the Brahma Jinalaya, an ancient Jain temple known for its exquisite architecture and detailed sculptures depicting Jain mythology.
- Explore the Veeranarayana Temple in Gadag, notable for its grand hall and sculpted pillars, reflecting the craftsmanship of the Chalukyan era.
- Visit the Nanneshwara Temple in Lakkundi, famous for its ornate carvings and historical significance in Karnataka's temple architecture.
- Arrive in Hampi and check-in at the hotel, immersing yourself in the historical ambiance of this UNESCO World Heritage site.
- Overnight in Hampi.

Day 2: Hampi

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before exploring the majestic Virupaksha Temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva and renowned for its towering gopura and richly carved pillars depicting mythological tales.

- Visit the Vittala Temple Complex, celebrated for its iconic stone chariot, musical pillars that produce melodious sounds when tapped, and the intricate craftsmanship of its sculptures.
- Wander through Hampi Bazaar, once a bustling marketplace during the Vijayanagar Empire, and admire its remnants and local handicrafts.
- Explore the Royal Enclosures, including the Queen's Bath, an ornate bathing pavilion surrounded by arched corridors and intricately carved arches, and the Hazara Rama Temple, adorned with intricate bas-reliefs depicting the Ramayana.
- Discover the Lotus Mahal, an architectural marvel blending Hindu and Islamic styles, featuring delicately carved arches and lotus-shaped domes that served as a royal pleasure pavilion.
- Visit the Achyutaraya Temple, dedicated to Lord Tiruvengalanatha and known for its impressive carvings depicting scenes from Hindu epics and celestial beings.
- Marvel at the monolithic statue of Lord Ganesha at the Sasivekalu Ganesha Temple, crafted from a single rock and revered for its artistic brilliance.
- Explore the Underground Shiva Temple, a unique structure carved out of a single rock, exemplifying the engineering prowess and religious fervor of the Vijayanagar artisans.
- Climb Matanga Hill for panoramic views of the sprawling ruins of Hampi and the Tungabhadra River, especially breathtaking during sunrise and sunset.
- Overnight in Hampi.

Day 3: Hampi - Hubli Airport (140kms)

- After breakfast at the hotel, embark on a final exploration of Hampi or relax amidst its serene landscapes.
- Depart for Hubli Airport, reflecting on the rich cultural heritage and architectural splendors of Hampi, concluding your memorable journey through the UNESCO World Heritage Sites of the Vijayanagar Empire.
