- Elephant Stables: Discover the majestic stables that once housed royal elephants, showcasing a blend of Hindu and Islamic architectural styles. Learn about the lifestyle of the royals and the care of elephants during the empire's heyday.

- Hampi Bazaar: Wander through the historic market street lined with pavilions, temples, and ancient merchant houses. Experience the bustling atmosphere of the local market and shop for souvenirs.
