Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Hubli to Hampi (140kms)

- After a hearty breakfast in Hubli, set out for the mystical land of Hampi.
- En route, visit Gadag to explore the intricately carved temples of the Durgadabbe Temple and the historic Sri Jagadguru Temple, showcasing ancient Karnataka architecture.
- Continue to Lakkundi, renowned for its group of ancient temples and stepwells like the Kaleshwara Temple and the Nanneshwara Temple, which highlight exquisite carvings and historical significance.
- Arrive in Hampi and check in at your hotel. The rest of the day is free for relaxation or exploring the local surroundings.

Day 2: Hampi Exploration

- Begin with a visit to the Virupaksha Temple, a grand shrine dedicated to Lord Shiva, known for its impressive architecture and historical importance.
- Explore the Vittala Temple, famous for its remarkable stone chariot and the musical pillars that produce melodious sounds.

- After the day's explorations, enjoy the evening relaxing or visiting local markets.

Day 3: Hampi to Hassan (330kms)

- Set out for Hassan with stops at significant sites along the way.
- Visit the Belur Chennakeshava Temple, renowned for its detailed sculptures depicting Hindu mythology, including the famous Yali carvings.
- Proceed to Halebedu to explore the Hoysaleswara Temple, notable for its intricate carvings and historical significance, showcasing the Hoysala dynasty's artistic achievements.
- Explore the Jain bastis of Shravanabelagola, where you can admire the historical and spiritual elements of Jainism, including the monolithic statue of Gomateshwara.
- Arrive in Hassan and check in at your hotel. Relax and reflect on the day's architectural wonders.

Day 4: Hassan to Mysore (140kms)

- Travel to Mysore and start with a visit to the Mysore Palace, an opulent structure known for its Indo-Saracenic architecture, stained glass windows, and ornate interiors.
- Explore the Brindavan Gardens, famous for its musical fountains, beautifully landscaped gardens, and a serene atmosphere ideal for relaxation.
- Ascend Chamundi Hills to visit the Chamundeshwari Temple, offering panoramic views of Mysore and significant religious importance.
- Visit the St. Philomena's Church, one of the largest churches in India, with its Gothic architecture and stained-glass windows.
- Conclude your day at Devaraja Market, a vibrant and bustling market known for its spices, silk, and local crafts, capturing the essence of Mysore.

Day 5: Mysore to Bangalore (145kms)

- Head to Bangalore and begin with a visit to Bangalore Palace, an architectural marvel reminiscent of English castles, featuring a lavish interior and sprawling grounds.
- Wander through Lalbagh Botanical Garden, a sprawling green space with diverse plant species, including a renowned glasshouse and the Lalbagh Rock.
- Explore Tipu Sultan's Summer Palace, an Indo-Islamic structure with ornate wooden pillars and intricate artwork depicting Tipu Sultan's era.
- Visit the Bull Temple, dedicated to Nandi, Lord Shiva's mount, known for its impressive monolithic bull statue and Dravidian architectural style.
- Stroll through the bustling streets of Commercial Street and Brigade Road for shopping and to experience Bangalore's vibrant atmosphere.

Day 6: Bangalore Departure

- Enjoy a leisurely breakfast and take advantage of any remaining free time to revisit favorite spots or explore new attractions in Bangalore.
- Visit the Government Museum, which houses a rich collection of artifacts, including ancient sculptures, coins, and paintings.
- Explore the serene Cubbon Park, an expansive green space perfect for a relaxing walk or leisurely afternoon.
- Conclude with a visit to the Santhome Cathedral, an important pilgrimage site with its neo-Gothic architecture and historical significance.
