Day 1: Hubli - Hampi (180kms)

Day 2: Hampi

- Start your day with breakfast at the hotel before visiting Virupaksha Temple, Hampi's oldest functioning temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva. Explore the Hampi Bazaar nearby, bustling with local crafts and souvenirs.

Day 3: Hampi - Bijapur (220kms)

- Visit Gol Gumbaz, an architectural marvel and the largest dome in India. Explore its whispering gallery, where even the softest sound echoes multiple times.
- Explore Ibrahim Rouza, a splendid mausoleum complex known for its symmetrically designed structures and serene gardens.
- Visit Malik-e-Maidan, a massive cannon weighing about 55 tons, and the elegant Jod Gumbaz, famous for its intricate carvings and historical significance. Return to your hotel in Bijapur for overnight stay.

Day 4: Bijapur - Badami (120kms)

- Depart for Badami after breakfast, known for its rock-cut cave temples dating back to the 6th century. Check into your hotel upon arrival in Badami.
- Explore the four rock-cut cave temples dedicated to various Hindu deities, showcasing stunning architecture and intricate sculptures.
- Climb up to Badami Fort, situated on a hilltop overlooking the town and Agastya Lake, offering panoramic views.
- Visit the Bhuthanatha Temples, located along the serene shores of Agastya Lake, known for their beautiful architectural details and peaceful surroundings.
- Explore the Aihole and Pattadakal temples, renowned for their Chalukyan architecture and intricate stone carvings. Return to your hotel in Badami for overnight stay.

Day 5: Badami - Goa (250kms)

- Depart for Goa after breakfast, known for its beautiful beaches, Portuguese heritage, and vibrant nightlife. Check into your hotel upon arrival in Goa.
- Relax and unwind on the beaches of North Goa, such as Calangute and Baga, or explore the historic churches and markets of Old Goa.
