Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Hyderabad - Bijapur (385 kms)

- Pick up from your hotel in Hyderabad.
- Drive to Bijapur, enroute visit Gulbarga.
- Explore Gulbarga Fort, known for its massive bastions and the Jama Masjid, showcasing impressive Indo-Islamic architecture.
- Visit Sharana Basaveshwara Temple, a significant pilgrimage site dedicated to the philosopher-saint Basaveshwara, with intricate carvings.
- Discover Jami Masjid, one of India's largest mosques, renowned for its elegant arches and expansive prayer hall.
- Continue to Bijapur and check into the hotel.

Day 2: Bijapur - Badami (120 kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit Gol Gumbaz, the mausoleum of Mohammed Adil Shah, famous for its whispering gallery and remarkable acoustics.
- Explore Ibrahim Rauza, the tomb of Ibrahim Adil Shah II, known for its symmetrical gardens and intricate carvings.

- See Malik-e-Maidan, one of the largest medieval cannons in the world, showcasing the Adil Shahi dynasty's military might.
- Discover Bara Kaman, an unfinished mausoleum with 12 arches, offering insight into Bijapur's architectural ambitions.
- Explore Bijapur Fort with its magnificent walls and significant monuments, offering panoramic city views.
- Visit Asar Mahal, a former court of justice and royal residence noted for its elegant arches and painted ceilings.
- Drive to Badami and check into the hotel.

Day 3: Badami

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit Badami Cave Temples, carved out of sandstone cliffs with intricate carvings.
- Enjoy the serene surroundings of Agastya Lake, surrounded by temples including the Bhutanatha group of temples.
- Climb up to Badami Fort, perched on a cliff with panoramic views of the town.
- Explore Aihole, known as the cradle of Hindu temple architecture, with over 125 temples and monuments dating back to the 6th century.
- Visit Pattadakal, a UNESCO World Heritage Site featuring a blend of northern and southern architectural styles with notable temples like Virupaksha and Sangameshwara.
- Discover Durga Temple in Aihole, renowned for its semi-circular apse and exquisite carvings, showcasing early Chalukyan architecture.
- Explore Sangameshwara Temple in Pattadakal, known for its Dravidian style and intricate sculptures.
- Visit Hemakuta Hill Temples, offering stunning views of the landscape and historic ruins.

Day 4: Badami - Hampi (180 kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Drive to Hampi.
- After check-in, meet your guide and visit Anegundi Village, known for its traditional crafts and vibrant local culture.

- Experience a traditional coracle boat ride on the Tungabhadra River, providing a unique perspective of the landscape and local fishing traditions.

Day 5: Hampi

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit Badavilinga Temple, home to the largest monolithic Shiva Linga in Hampi, a place of serene worship and spiritual significance.
- Explore Lakshmi Narasimha Temple, featuring a colossal statue of Lord Narasimha, a marvel of Vijayanagara architecture.
- Discover Underground Shiva Temple, an ancient temple partially submerged under water, known for its unique location.
- Visit Virupaksha Temple, one of the oldest functioning temples in India, known for its stunning architecture and intricate sculptures.
- Explore Vittala Temple, famous for its iconic stone chariot and musical pillars that produce notes when tapped.
- Discover the Royal Enclosure, remnants of grand structures that housed the royal court and administrative buildings.
- Visit Lotus Mahal, an example of Indo-Islamic architecture, serving as a pleasure palace for the royal women.
- Explore Elephant Stables, majestic structures that once housed the royal elephants.
- Visit Hazara Rama Temple, known for its frescoes depicting scenes from the Ramayana.
- Explore Hemakuta Hill Temples, offering panoramic views of Hampi's monuments and rocky landscape.
- See Sasivekalu Ganesha and Kadalekalu Ganesha, monolithic statues of Lord Ganesha with intricate carvings.
- Visit Hampi Bazaar, once a bustling market, now lined with ancient ruins and remnants of past trade.
- Discover Malyavanta Raghunathaswamy Temple, perched on a hilltop, offering panoramic views and associated with the Ramayana.

Day 6: Hampi - Hyderabad (380 kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.

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- Drive back to Hyderabad, concluding the tour with memories of the rich historical and architectural heritage experienced during the trip.
