- Explore Gadag's Trikuteshwara Temple, renowned for its intricate carvings and architectural beauty, and the Veeranarayana Temple, celebrated for its detailed sculptures.
- Visit Lakkundi, famous for its ancient step wells and intricate sculptures. Explore the Musukina Bavi step well and admire the beautiful carvings and historical significance.
- Arrive in Hampi by evening and explore Hampi Bazaar, a lively area filled with local crafts, traditional snacks, and vibrant street life.
- Enjoy the unique landscape of Hampi, characterized by ancient ruins, boulders, and the serene Tungabhadra River.
- Dinner at a local restaurant with traditional Hampi cuisine and relax at your hotel.

Day 6: Hampi UNESCO World Heritage Exploration
