Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Hyderabad

- Arrive at Hyderabad airport where our representative will assist with your transfer to the hotel.
- Check-in at your hotel and relax for the rest of the day. Enjoy local markets or sample traditional cuisine if you wish.

Day 2: Hyderabad City Tour

- Start your day with a hearty breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit the Charminar, an iconic 16th-century monument known for its four grand arches and intricate stucco work. The monument stands amidst a bustling market, offering a glimpse into Hyderabad's vibrant culture.
- Explore Golconda Fort, famous for its acoustic system and panoramic views from the top. The fort houses several ancient palaces, temples, and mosques within its massive walls.
- Proceed to Mecca Masjid, one of the oldest and largest mosques in India. Admire its grand architecture, with bricks made from soil brought from Mecca.

- Discover the Salar Jung Museum, which houses an extensive collection of art, manuscripts, and antiques from across the world, including the famous Veiled Rebecca statue.
- End your day with a visit to Chowmohalla Palace, the opulent former residence of the Nizams, renowned for its stunning courtyards, gardens, and grand halls.
- Enjoy a relaxing boat ride on Hussain Sagar Lake, and visit Lumbini Park for an evening view of the illuminated Buddha statue.

Day 3: Hyderabad - Gulbarga - Vijayapura (385kms)

- Start your day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Embark on a scenic drive to Gulbarga.
- In Gulbarga, visit Gulbarga Fort, a large fortification with impressive walls, ancient mosques, and palaces. The fort's design reflects the architectural style of the Bahmani Sultanate.
- Explore Jama Masjid, an imposing mosque with a spacious courtyard and an elegant prayer hall supported by numerous pillars.
- Visit the shrine of Hazrat Khwaja Bande Nawaz, a revered Sufi saint, which draws pilgrims and tourists alike with its spiritual significance.
- Continue your drive to Vijayapura, check in at your hotel, and relax after the journey.

Day 4: Vijayapura - Hampi (215kms)

- Enjoy a breakfast at the hotel before beginning your day.
- Begin your exploration of Vijayapura with a visit to Vijayapura Fort, which features grand gates, bastions, and a moat.
- Explore Asar Mahal, known for its unique architectural style and the beautifully carved arches.
- Visit Gol Gumbaz, the mausoleum of Mohammed Adil Shah, famous for its massive dome and the whispering gallery that allows sounds to travel across the dome.
- See Jama Masjid, one of the largest mosques in India, known for its grand structure and historical importance.
- Admire Malik-e-Maidan, an enormous cannon located at the Asar Mahal, a symbol of the city's military strength.

- Drive to Hampi, check in at your hotel, and unwind in the evening, soaking in the historical atmosphere of the area.

Day 5: Hampi Exploration

- Begin with a breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit the Virupaksha Temple, an ancient temple dedicated to Lord Shiva, featuring elaborate carvings and a sacred atmosphere.
- Explore Vittala Temple, renowned for its Stone Chariot and musical pillars that produce melodic sounds when struck.
- Discover the Royal Enclosure, a fortified area with royal palaces, audience halls, and intricate water management systems.
- Marvel at Hazara Rama Temple, which is covered in detailed bas-reliefs depicting scenes from the Ramayana, offering insights into the epic's stories.
- Visit the Elephant Stables, a grand structure used for housing royal elephants, showcasing a blend of Islamic and Hindu architectural styles.
- Optionally, explore Achyutaraya Temple with its richly decorated sculptures or hike to Matanga Hill for panoramic views of the Hampi ruins.

Day 6: Hampi - Hyderabad (380kms)

- After breakfast at the hotel, begin your drive back to Hyderabad.
- Reflect on the rich history and architectural wonders you've experienced during the journey.
- Upon arrival in Hyderabad, you will be dropped off at your hotel or the airport, concluding your memorable tour.
