Day 1: Jabalpur - Bandhavgarh National Park (165kms)

- Depart from Jabalpur, a city nestled along the banks of the Narmada River, known for its marble rocks and scenic beauty. Travel through verdant landscapes to reach Bandhavgarh National Park, celebrated for its dense forests and ancient ruins. Day 2: Bandhavgarh National Park

Explore the site's historical and artistic significance, marveling at the intricate depictions of early human life. Arrive in Bhopal, the capital city of Madhya Pradesh, and check-in at your hotel. All meals included at the hotel.
