Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Delhi - Jaipur (265kms)

- Depart from Delhi and drive to Jaipur, the capital city of Rajasthan known as the "Pink City."
- Discover the vibrant local markets, such as Johari Bazaar and Bapu Bazaar, famous for textiles, jewelry, and handicrafts.
- Enjoy traditional Rajasthani cuisine at a local restaurant, savoring specialties like dal bati churma and laal maas.
- Experience the cultural richness at the Albert Hall Museum, an imposing Indo-Saracenic architectural marvel showcasing Rajasthan's history through artifacts, paintings, and sculptures.
- Visit Birla Mandir, a modern white marble temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu and Goddess Lakshmi, offering serene views of Jaipur at sunset.

Day 2: Jaipur

- Start with breakfast at the hotel before sightseeing.
- Visit the majestic Amber Fort, located on a hilltop overlooking Maota Lake. Explore its intricate Hindu-style architecture, including the Sheesh Mahal (Hall of Mirrors) known for its reflective glasswork.

- Explore Mandawa town and visit prominent havelis like the Goenka Double Haveli, adorned with elaborate frescoes depicting mythological themes, daily life, and historical events.
- Discover Murmuria Haveli, known for its exquisite frescoes showcasing scenes of royal processions and Rajasthani culture.
- Witness the unique artwork depicting themes from Hindu mythology and Mughal influences in the frescoes that adorn the walls of Mandawa's havelis.
- Immerse yourself in the vibrant culture and architectural splendor of Rajasthan's rural heartland.

Day 4: Mandawa - Delhi (250kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel before departing for Delhi.
- Explore the local markets offering traditional Rajasthani handicrafts such as lac bangles, tie-dye fabrics, and wooden artifacts.
- Experience the charm of Rajasthan's rural life and architecture before concluding your journey in Delhi, reminiscing about the rich cultural heritage and artistic marvels of Rajasthan.
