Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Delhi

- Arrive in Delhi, where you'll be welcomed and transferred to your hotel. After checking in, take some time to rest and recover from your journey. Day 2: Delhi

- Enjoy a visit to Mehtab Bagh, offering panoramic views of the Taj Mahal from across the Yamuna River during sunset.
- Overnight in Agra.

Day 4: Agra - Jaipur (245kms)

- En route to Jaipur, visit Fatehpur Sikri, a UNESCO World Heritage site and a well-preserved ghost town, showcasing the architectural brilliance of the Mughal era.
- Continue to Jaipur, the "Pink City" of Rajasthan.
- Evening at leisure to explore local markets and savor Rajasthani cuisine.
- Overnight in Jaipur.

Day 5: Jaipur

- Begin with breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit Amber Fort, a majestic fortress perched on a hilltop. Enjoy an elephant ride or jeep ride to the fort entrance and explore its palaces, courtyards, and panoramic views of the surrounding hills.
- Explore the City Palace, a blend of Rajasthani and Mughal architecture, housing museums with royal artifacts and costumes.
- Visit Jantar Mantar, an astronomical observatory and UNESCO World Heritage site, featuring ancient instruments for astronomical observations.
- Discover Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds), an iconic Jaipur landmark known for its intricate facade and historical significance.
- Overnight in Jaipur.

Day 6: Jaipur - Udaipur (405kms)

- After breakfast, embark on a scenic drive to Udaipur, known as the "City of Lakes."
- En route, visit the majestic Chittorgarh Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage site, known for its grand architecture and historical significance (optional visit).
- Arrive in Udaipur and enjoy an evening boat ride on Lake Pichola, passing by Jag Mandir Palace and enjoying the scenic views of the lake and surrounding hills.
- Overnight in Udaipur.

Day 7: Udaipur

- Start with breakfast at the hotel.
- Explore the City Palace complex, overlooking Lake Pichola. Visit its museums, courtyards, and the exquisite Crystal Gallery.
- Visit Jagdish Temple, a large Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu, known for its intricate architecture and carvings.
- Discover Saheliyon Ki Bari (Garden of Maidens), a serene garden adorned with fountains, kiosks, marble elephants, and lush greenery.
- Optional: Visit Shilpgram, a rural arts and crafts complex showcasing traditional Rajasthani art and culture.
- Overnight in Udaipur.

Day 8: Udaipur - Mumbai (flight)

- Fly to Mumbai, India's financial capital.
- Visit the Gateway of India, a historic monument overlooking the Arabian Sea, and explore its surroundings.
- Discover the Prince of Wales Museum (Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Vastu Sangrahalaya), housing a vast collection of artifacts and exhibits on Indian history and culture.
- Explore Dhobi Ghat, Mumbai's famous open-air laundry where clothes are washed in traditional style.
- Overnight in Mumbai.

Day 9: Mumbai

- After breakfast, visit Elephanta Caves, a UNESCO World Heritage site on Elephanta Island, known for its rock-cut temples dedicated to Lord Shiva.
- Explore Colaba and Crawford Market for shopping and local street food experiences.
- Visit Hanging Gardens and Kamala Nehru Park for panoramic views of the city skyline and Marine Drive.
- Evening at leisure to explore Mumbai's nightlife or relax.
- Overnight in Mumbai.

Day 10: Mumbai - Goa (flight)

- Fly to Goa, known for its pristine beaches and Portuguese heritage.
- Relax on the beach or explore local markets and beachside shacks.
- Overnight in Goa.

Day 11: Goa

- After breakfast, explore Old Goa's cultural heritage with visits to Basilica of Bom Jesus and Se Cathedral, reflecting Goa's rich Christian history and architecture.
- Spend leisure time at Anjuna or Baga Beach, known for water sports and beachside activities.
- Overnight in Goa.

Day 12: Goa

- Explore South Goa, visiting Mangueshi Temple and Shantadurga Temple, showcasing Goa's vibrant Hindu culture and architecture.
- Visit Colva Beach, a serene stretch with white sands and clear waters, ideal for relaxation and optional water sports.
- Evening at leisure to enjoy the beach or explore local markets.
- Overnight in Goa.

Day 13: Goa - Cochin (flight)

- Fly to Cochin (Kochi), known for its cultural diversity and historic landmarks.
