Day 1: Arrive Udaipur

- Arrive in Udaipur, known as the "City of Lakes," and check-in at your hotel. The city's ambiance blends regal heritage with stunning lakeside views, offering a perfect introduction to Rajasthan's cultural richness.

Day 2: Udaipur

- Visit Bagore ki Haveli, a historic mansion showcasing Rajputana architecture and cultural artifacts. Dive into Rajasthan's rich heritage through its display of traditional costumes, puppets, musical instruments, and intricate wall paintings.
- Optionally, drive up to Sajjangarh Fort (Monsoon Palace) for breathtaking views of Udaipur city and the Aravalli hills during sunset, capturing the essence of Rajasthan's royal grandeur.

Day 3: Udaipur - Mount Abu (165kms)

- Depart for Mount Abu, Rajasthan's hill station nestled in the Aravalli Range, offering a refreshing change of climate and scenic landscapes.
- Explore the renowned Dilwara Temples, a complex of Jain temples known for their extraordinary marble craftsmanship. Admire the intricate carvings depicting Jain teachings, celestial beings, and floral motifs, showcasing unparalleled architectural finesse.
- Visit Nakki Lake, surrounded by hills and legends, where you can indulge in a peaceful boat ride or simply relax by the serene shores, absorbing the tranquility and natural beauty of the surroundings.

Day 4: Mount Abu - Ahmedabad (280kms)

- Drive to Ahmedabad, Gujarat's vibrant cultural capital, with enriching stops at Patan and Modhera.
- In Patan, explore Rani ki Vav, an ancient stepwell recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Descend into its intricately designed levels adorned with sculptures of deities, celestial beings, and mythological creatures, symbolizing reverence for water as a life-giving element and showcasing India's architectural prowess.
- Continue to Modhera to marvel at the Sun Temple, an architectural masterpiece dedicated to the sun god Surya. Admire its symmetrical layout, intricate carvings, and the sanctum designed to capture the first rays of the rising sun, reflecting Gujarat's rich cultural heritage and devotion to celestial deities.

Day 5: Ahmedabad - Departure

- Dive into Gujarat's textile heritage at the Calico Museum of Textiles, home to a remarkable collection of historical fabrics, tapestries, and artifacts spanning centuries, showcasing India's diverse weaving traditions and craftsmanship.
- Take a leisurely stroll along the Sabarmati Riverfront, a modern promenade offering panoramic views of the river and vibrant recreational spaces, reflecting Ahmedabad's evolution as a modern metropolis rooted in its historical past.
