Tour Overview

Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Kullu - Manali (125kms)

- Arrive at Kullu airport and meet your driver & guide. Begin by exploring the picturesque Kullu Valley, renowned for its lush green landscapes, serene river streams, and apple orchards.
- Visit Manikaran, a significant pilgrimage site for both Sikhs and Hindus. Explore the famous hot springs and the revered Gurudwara and temple complex.
- Proceed to Manali, a charming hill station nestled in the Beas River Valley. Check-in at the hotel and relax after the journey.
- Overnight at the hotel in Manali.

Day 2: Manali

- After breakfast, visit the iconic Hidimba Devi Temple, dedicated to the wife of Bhima from the Mahabharata. The temple is set amidst cedar forests and features intricately carved wooden architecture.
- Explore the ancient Manu Temple, dedicated to Sage Manu, the mythical creator of human race according to Hindu mythology.

- Visit Vashisht Village renowned for its hot water springs believed to have medicinal properties. Also, explore the Tibetan monasteries - Himalayan Nyingmapa Gumpa & Gadhan Thekchhokling Gumpa - reflecting Tibetan Buddhist culture.
- Spend leisure time at Old Manali, known for its laid-back vibe, cafes, and shops offering local handicrafts and souvenirs.
- Overnight at the hotel in Manali.

Day 3: Manali - Rohtang Pass Excursion - Manali

- Enjoy an early breakfast and embark on a full-day excursion to Rohtang Pass, situated at an altitude of 3,980 meters in the Pir Panjal Range.
- Marvel at the breathtaking views of snow-capped peaks, glaciers, and the lush green valleys below. Rohtang Pass serves as a gateway to the Lahaul and Spiti Valleys.
- Explore the adventure activities available, including snow skiing (subject to availability), snow scooter rides, and mountain trekking.
- Return to Manali in the evening and spend the rest of the day at leisure, strolling along The Mall, shopping for local handicrafts, or relaxing at your hotel.
- Overnight at the hotel in Manali.

Day 4: Manali - Shimla (250kms)

- After breakfast, drive to Shimla, the erstwhile summer capital of British India, nestled amidst the lofty Himalayas.
- Check-in at the hotel and unwind. Shimla is known for its colonial architecture, pine forests, and panoramic views of the surrounding hills.
- Enjoy free time to explore The Mall, Shimla's vibrant promenade lined with shops, cafes, and colonial-era buildings.
- Overnight at the hotel in Shimla.

Day 5: Shimla

- Begin the day with a visit to The Ridge, a sprawling open space offering panoramic views of the Shimla Valley and distant snow-capped peaks.
- Explore The Mall, Shimla's main shopping and social hub. Indulge in shopping for local handicrafts, woollens, and souvenirs.

- Visit Christ Church, built in neo-gothic style and known for its stunning stained glass windows. It is one of the oldest churches in North India.
- Discover Jakhoo Temple, dedicated to Lord Hanuman and situated atop Jakhoo Hill, offering panoramic views of Shimla.
- Visit the State Museum showcasing Himachal Pradesh's rich cultural heritage through artifacts, textiles, and archaeological exhibits.
- Overnight at the hotel in Shimla.

Day 6: Shimla - Chail & Kufri Excursion - Shimla

- After breakfast, embark on a day excursion to Chail, known for its pristine forests and the world's highest cricket ground.
- Visit Kufri, a picturesque hill station offering panoramic views of the Himalayas. Enjoy activities like horse riding, yak rides, and nature walks.
- Return to Shimla in the evening and spend leisure time exploring more of The Mall or relaxing at your hotel.
- Overnight at the hotel in Shimla.

Day 7: Shimla - Toy Train to Chandigarh - Delhi

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and transfer to Shimla railway station to board the UNESCO World Heritage Toy Train to Kalka.
- Experience the scenic journey through 102 tunnels, 864 bridges, and picturesque landscapes as the train descends from Shimla to Kalka.
- Transfer from Kalka railway station to Chandigarh airport for your onward flight to Delhi.
- A vehicle will be provided in Delhi for transit to your desired location or connecting flights.
- Conclude the tour with cherished memories of exploring the enchanting Himalayan cities of Kullu, Manali, and Shimla
