Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Udaipur

- Arrive at Udaipur airport, where you will be greeted and transferred to your hotel.
- Rest and relax at the hotel to recover from your journey.
- After settling in, enjoy a delightful boat ride on Lake Pichola, soaking in views of the City Palace and Jag Mandir.
- Overnight at the hotel in Udaipur.

Day 2: Udaipur

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Full-day city tour of Udaipur:

- Evening: Attend the captivating folk dance show "Dharohar" at Bagore ki Haveli, showcasing Rajasthani cultural heritage.
- Overnight at the hotel in Udaipur.

Day 3: Udaipur - Jodhpur (265kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Drive to Jodhpur, stopping en route to visit:
- The exquisite Ranakpur Jain Temple, renowned for its stunning architecture, 1,444 intricately carved marble pillars, and unique domes.
- Continue journey to Jodhpur and check in at the hotel.
- Rest of the day free for leisure or personal activities.
- Overnight at the hotel in Jodhpur.

Day 4: Jodhpur

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Full-day city tour of Jodhpur:
- Explore the imposing Mehrangarh Fort, perched on a hilltop offering panoramic views of the Blue City, featuring palatial complexes, courtyards, and museums displaying royal artifacts.
- Visit Jaswant Thada, a serene white marble cenotaph built in memory of Maharaja Jaswant Singh II, adorned with intricate marble lattice screens.
- Discover the opulent Umaid Bhawan Palace, a grand structure blending Rajputana and European architectural styles, now partly a museum and heritage hotel.
- Excursion to Mandore Gardens, housing royal cenotaphs, temples, and lush green gardens with peacocks.
- Overnight at the hotel in Jodhpur.

Day 5: Jodhpur - Jaisalmer (265kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Drive to Jaisalmer, with a visit en route to:
- Pokhran Fort and Palaces, a historical site with a museum showcasing artifacts, weapons, and royal attire.
- Arrive in Jaisalmer and check in at the hotel.
- Rest and relax.
- Overnight at the hotel in Jaisalmer.

Day 6: Jaisalmer

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Full-day exploration of Jaisalmer:
- Visit the majestic Jaisalmer Fort (Sonar Quila), a UNESCO World Heritage site and the "Golden Fort," with narrow lanes, temples, palaces, and havelis.
- Explore Patwon Ki Haveli, a cluster of five intricately carved havelis showcasing elaborate architecture and frescoes.
- Discover Salim Ji Ki Haveli and Nathmal Ji Ki Haveli, known for their distinct architectural styles and exquisite craftsmanship.
- Visit Mandir Palace, a beautiful palace adorned with delicate stone carvings and ornate balconies.
- Explore Bada Bagh, a complex of royal cenotaphs set amidst gardens and carved chhatris.
- Excursion to Kuldhara, an abandoned village with a mysterious past and ghostly tales.
- Visit Gadi Sagar Lake (Gadisar Lake), an artificial reservoir surrounded by temples, pavilions, and ghats.
- Later, venture to Sam Sand Dunes for a desert safari, camel rides, cultural performances, and mesmerizing sunset views over the dunes.
- Return to Jaisalmer for dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 7: Jaisalmer - Departure

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Transfer to Jaisalmer airport as per your flight schedule for onward journey.
