- Visit Sumur Village, known for its beautiful orchards and the serene Samstanling Monastery.
- Explore Panamik Village, famous for its hot springs believed to have medicinal properties and its scenic surroundings.
- Visit Yarab Tso Lake, a hidden gem in Nubra Valley known for its pristine beauty and peaceful environment.

Day 4: Nubra - Pangong Lake (150kms)

- Arrive at Pangong Lake, a high-altitude lake known for its ever-changing blue hues and stunning mountain backdrop.

- Visit Hemis Monastery, the largest and wealthiest monastery in Ladakh, known for its annual Hemis Festival and impressive collection of ancient artifacts.
- Explore Thiksey Monastery, a beautiful monastery resembling the Potala Palace in Lhasa, offering panoramic views of the Indus Valley.
- Visit Shey Palace, the former summer retreat of the Ladakhi kings, known for its large gold-plated Buddha statue and picturesque setting.
- Explore Stok Palace and Museum, the residence of the royal family of Ladakh, showcasing royal artifacts, jewelry, and thangkas.
- Visit the Magnetic Hill, a gravity hill where vehicles seem to defy gravity and move uphill on their own.

Day 6: Leh - Departure

- Start with breakfast at the hotel.
- Transfer to the airport for your onward journey. End of the tour.
