- Upon arrival in Udaipur, unwind with a serene boat ride on Lake Pichola during sunset, soaking in breathtaking views of the City Palace and Jag Mandir.
- Overnight in Udaipur.

- After the visit, continue to Jodhpur and check into your hotel.
- The evening is free for leisure or personal exploration of the local market, where you can shop for traditional Jodhpur handicrafts.
- Overnight in Jodhpur.

Day 8: Jodhpur Sightseeing

- Overnight stay in Jodhpur.
