Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Mumbai

- Arrive in Mumbai, the bustling metropolis known as the "City of Dreams" and India's financial capital. Check into your hotel and unwind after your journey.

Day 2: Mumbai

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit the Gateway of India, an iconic monument and Mumbai's most famous landmark, offering stunning views of the Arabian Sea and serving as a starting point for boat tours to Elephanta Caves.

Day 4: Daman - Ankleshwar (200kms)

- Proceed to Ankleshwar, an industrial city on the banks of the Narmada River.
- Visit Golden Bridge, an engineering marvel and a crucial link over the Narmada River, offering scenic views of the river and surrounding landscapes.
- Explore Shoolpaneshwar Wildlife Sanctuary, a sanctuary known for its rich biodiversity and picturesque landscapes, ideal for nature walks and wildlife spotting.

Day 5: Ankleshwar - Kevadia (90kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Drive to Kevadia, home to the Statue of Unity, the world's tallest statue standing at 182 meters. Explore the statue and the memorial complex dedicated to Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, India's first Deputy Prime Minister.
- Visit Valley of Flowers, a landscaped garden surrounding the statue, offering serene walks and picturesque views of the Narmada River.
- Enjoy a boat ride on the Sardar Sarovar Dam reservoir, providing scenic views and insights into the dam's significance for Gujarat's irrigation and hydroelectric power generation.

Day 6: Kevadia - Vadodara (150kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Head to Vadodara, known for its rich cultural heritage and architectural splendor.
- Visit Laxmi Vilas Palace, a majestic palace built in Indo-Saracenic style with exquisite interiors, royal artifacts, and sprawling gardens.
- Explore Champaner-Pavagadh Archaeological Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its ancient forts, palaces, mosques, and step wells dating back to the 8th to 14th centuries.

Day 7: Vadodara - Ahmedabad (110kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Drive to Ahmedabad, Gujarat's largest city and an important cultural and commercial hub.
- Visit Sabarmati Ashram, Mahatma Gandhi's former residence and a symbol of India's freedom struggle, with a museum showcasing Gandhi's life and principles.

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- Explore Jama Masjid, one of the finest examples of Indo-Islamic architecture in Ahmedabad, known for its intricately carved pillars and domes.
- Shop and explore Manek Chowk, a bustling market known for its jewelry, textiles, and traditional Gujarati snacks like dhokla and fafda.

Day 8: Ahmedabad - Mumbai (flight)

- Breakfast at the hotel in Ahmedabad.
- Transfer to Ahmedabad Airport for your departure flight to Mumbai.
