Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Mumbai

Day 6: Ratnagiri - Goa (295kms)

- Explore Thibaw Palace, built for the exiled king and queen of Burma, now housing a museum.

- Drive to Goa, known for its Portuguese heritage and pristine beaches.
- Check-in to your hotel and relax.

Day 7: Goa

- Start with breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit Basilica of Bom Jesus, a UNESCO World Heritage Site housing the mortal remains of St. Francis Xavier and showcasing Baroque architecture.
- Explore Se Cathedral, one of the largest churches in Asia, known for its Portuguese-Gothic style and the Golden Bell.
