Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Mumbai

- Upon arrival at Mumbai airport, our representative will greet you and facilitate a transfer to your hotel.
- Check-in and relax after your journey.
- Overnight stay in Mumbai.

Day 2: Mumbai

- Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at the hotel before starting your day.
- Begin your Mumbai exploration with a visit to the iconic Gateway of India, a symbol of the city's rich colonial history and bustling waterfront.
- Visit Elephanta Caves, accessible by ferry from the Gateway of India, famous for its rock-cut temples dedicated to Lord Shiva and intricate sculptures.
- Dive into Mumbai's vibrant culture with a stroll through Colaba Causeway, a bustling street market offering a variety of goods and street food.
- Explore the Prince of Wales Museum (Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Vastu Sangrahalaya), showcasing a vast collection of art, archaeology, and natural history.

- Discover the Hanging Gardens (Pherozeshah Mehta Gardens), offering panoramic views of the city and the Arabian Sea.
- Explore the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (Victoria Terminus), a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its stunning Victorian Gothic architecture.
- Overnight stay in Mumbai.

Day 3: Mumbai - Aurangabad (Flight)

- After breakfast, transfer to Mumbai airport for your flight to Aurangabad.
- Upon arrival, check-in at the hotel and relax.
- Excursion to explore the Aurangabad Caves, ancient rock-cut Buddhist caves dating back to the 6th and 7th centuries.
- visit Daulatabad Fort
- Visit Bibi ka Maqbara, often referred to as the "Mini Taj Mahal", built by Aurangzeb in memory of his wife.
- Panchakki
- Overnight stay in Aurangabad.

Day 4: Aurangabad - Ajanta - Aurangabad (210kms round)

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before departing for a full-day excursion to Ajanta Caves, a UNESCO World Heritage site famous for its ancient Buddhist cave temples and exquisite murals.
- Marvel at the detailed carvings and paintings depicting the life of Buddha and Buddhist teachings.
- Return to Aurangabad and visit Aurangabad caves.
- Overnight stay in Aurangabad.

Day 5: Aurangabad - Nashik (170kms)

- After breakfast, drive to Nashik, known for its spiritual significance and vineyards.
- Upon arrival in Nashik, visit Trimbakeshwar Shiva Temple, one of the twelve Jyotirlingas, revered for its religious importance and architecture.
- Explore Pandavleni Caves, ancient rock-cut caves with intricate sculptures and Buddhist carvings.
- Overnight stay in Nashik.

Day 6: Nashik - Kevadia (350kms)

- Depart for Kevadia after breakfast, a journey that takes you through scenic landscapes.
- En route, stop at Saputara Hill Station (optional), known for its serene environment and tribal culture.
- Upon arrival in Kevadia, check-in at the hotel and relax.
- Visit the Statue of Unity, the world's tallest statue, dedicated to Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, with panoramic views from the observation deck.
- Attend the Laser Light and Sound show depicting the life of Sardar Patel in the evening.
- Overnight stay in Kevadia.

Day 7: Kevadia

- Start your day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit the Sardar Sarovar Dam, a major hydroelectric and irrigation project on the Narmada River, offering breathtaking views and a boat ride experience.
- Explore the Valley of Flowers, a lush garden near the Statue of Unity showcasing indigenous flora and fauna.
- Visit the Cactus Garden and Butterfly Garden nearby.
- Return to the hotel for an evening at leisure.
- Overnight stay in Kevadia.

Day 8: Kevadia - Vadodara (150kms)

- After breakfast, drive to Vadodara.
- Check-in at the hotel and relax.
- Visit Laxmi Vilas Palace, an architectural marvel with Indo-Saracenic design and lush gardens.
- Explore Maharaja Fateh Singh Museum, known for its collection of art, sculptures, and royal artifacts.
- Overnight stay in Vadodara.

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Day 9: Vadodara - Departure

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and some free time for last-minute shopping or additional sightseeing.
- Depending on your departure schedule, transfer to the airport for your onward journey, concluding your enriching tour of modern cities and ancient caves in Western India.
