Day 5: Udaipur - Jodhpur (265kms)

- Check-in at your hotel in Jodhpur.

Day 6: Jodhpur

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Explore Mehrangarh Fort, a massive fort known for its impressive architecture and panoramic views.
- Visit Jaswant Thada, a beautiful marble cenotaph with intricate carvings and peaceful surroundings.
- Visit to Umaid Bhawan Palace Museum or enjoy a leisurely evening in the city.
- Explore Mandore Gardens, featuring temples, memorials, and lush green landscapes.

- Visit Clock Tower and Sardar Market for local handicrafts, spices, and textiles.
- Optional visit to Rao Jodha Desert Rock Park for a nature walk and desert flora.
- Evening visit to the bustling Sadar Bazaar for shopping and street food.

Day 7: Jodhpur - Jaipur (330kms)

- After breakfast, drive to Jaipur, the "Pink City."
- En route visit the village of Pushkar, famous for its Brahma Temple and Pushkar Lake.
- Check-in at your hotel in Jaipur.

Day 8: Jaipur

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit Amber Fort, a stunning hilltop fort-palace with intricate architecture and sweeping views.
- Explore City Palace, a blend of Rajasthani and Mughal architecture, housing museums and courtyards.
- Discover Jantar Mantar, an astronomical observatory with intriguing instruments for accurate measurements.
- Drive past Hawa Mahal, the iconic "Palace of Winds," known for its intricate facade.
- Shopping at vibrant markets like Johari Bazaar and Bapu Bazaar for textiles, jewelry, and handicrafts.
- Evening visit to Nahargarh Fort for panoramic views of Jaipur city at sunset.

Day 9: Jaipur - Agra (245kms)

- After breakfast at the hotel in Jaipur, embark on a scenic drive to Agra, home of the iconic Taj Mahal.
- En route, stop to visit Abhaneri Stepwell, a stunning medieval stepwell known for its intricate architecture and historical significance.
- Continue your journey to Fatehpur Sikri, the UNESCO World Heritage site and former Mughal capital, known for its red sandstone architecture, palaces, and mosques.
- Arrive in Agra and check-in at your hotel.

Day 10: Agra - Delhi (204kms)

- Early morning visit to Taj Mahal, a masterpiece of white marble and a symbol of eternal love.
- Return to the hotel for breakfast.
- Visit Agra Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage site with impressive palaces, mosques, and views of Taj Mahal from Mehtab Bagh.
- Visit Akbar's Tomb in Sikandra, showcasing a blend of Hindu, Islamic, Buddhist, Jain, and Christian motifs.
- Drive to Delhi and check-in at your hotel.

Day 11: Delhi
