Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Udaipur

- Arrive in Udaipur and check into your hotel (check-in time from 2 PM, early check-in subject to room availability).
- Rest and refresh at the hotel after your journey.
- Enjoy a leisurely boat ride on Lake Pichola, where you can admire the scenic surroundings and visit Jag Mandir, a palace on an island in the lake offering panoramic views.

Day 2: Udaipur

- Start the day with breakfast at your hotel.

- Visit the Shilpgram Art and Craft Village to witness traditional Rajasthani arts and crafts, including pottery, textiles, and handcrafted items.
- In the evening, stroll through the local markets around the City Palace and Jagdish Temple area for traditional Rajasthani handicrafts, jewelry, textiles, and souvenirs. Don't miss the vibrant bazaars offering everything from colorful bandhani fabrics to intricately designed silver jewelry.

Day 3: Udaipur - Ranakpur - Bishnoi Village - Jodhpur (260kms)

- After breakfast, depart for Ranakpur.
- Visit the famous Jain Temples of Ranakpur, renowned for their intricate marble architecture and 1,444 exquisitely carved pillars. Explore the temples' different chambers, each with unique motifs and designs.
- Drive through the Bishnoi Village, known for its conservation efforts and vibrant rural life. Witness local artisans at work and traditional handicrafts.
- Proceed to Jodhpur and check into your hotel.

Day 4: Jodhpur

- Enjoy breakfast at your hotel.
- Begin your day exploring Mehrangarh Fort, towering above the blue city of Jodhpur. Discover its palaces, courtyards, and a museum housing a splendid collection of artifacts and paintings. Don't miss the panoramic views of the city from its ramparts.
- Visit Jaswant Thada, a white marble cenotaph built in memory of Maharaja Jaswant Singh II, offering serene gardens and intricate lattice work.

- Explore Mandore Gardens, ancient capital of the Marwar dynasty, known for its historic cenotaphs, temples, and lush greenery. Admire the architecture and peaceful ambiance.
- Return to Jodhpur and explore the bustling Sardar Market, where you can shop for textiles, handicrafts, spices, and traditional Jodhpuri attire. Experience the vibrant atmosphere and local flavors.
- Visit the Umaid Bhawan Palace Museum, a splendid example of Indo-Saracenic architecture and the current residence of the royal family of Jodhpur.

Day 5: Jodhpur - Pushkar - Jaipur (310kms)

- After breakfast, depart for Pushkar.
- Visit the Brahma Temple, one of the few temples dedicated to Lord Brahma, known for its red spire and peaceful ambiance. Participate in the rituals and explore the temple's architectural beauty.
- Explore the sacred Pushkar Lake and its 52 ghats, where pilgrims perform rituals and prayers. Witness the serene sunset over the lake.
- Continue your journey to Jaipur, the vibrant capital of Rajasthan, and check into your hotel.

Day 6: Jaipur

- Start your day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit the iconic Amber Fort, situated on a hilltop and known for its blend of Rajput and Mughal architecture. Enjoy an elephant ride to the fort entrance and explore its palaces, courtyards, and gardens. Don't miss the Sheesh Mahal (Mirror Palace) with its intricate mirror work.

Day 7: Jaipur - Mandawa (170kms)

- After breakfast, drive to Mandawa, a town famous for its beautifully painted havelis (mansions) adorned with frescoes depicting mythological themes and historical events. Explore the intricacies of local art and architecture, including havelis such as:
- Hanuman Prasad Goenka Haveli: Known for its intricate frescoes and detailed artwork.
- Murmuria Haveli: Renowned for its striking blue tiles and exquisite paintings.
- Goenka Double Haveli: Admire its elaborate carvings and vibrant murals depicting daily life scenes.
- Visit Mandawa Fort, an ancient citadel that offers panoramic views of the town and houses artifacts showcasing the region's rich history and culture.
- Overnight stay in Mandawa amidst the charming rural landscapes.

Day 8: Mandawa - Delhi (250kms)

- After breakfast, depart for Delhi.
- Upon arrival in Delhi, check into your hotel.

Day 9: Delhi
