Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Udaipur

- Explore the Vintage Car Museum, housing a remarkable collection of classic cars belonging to the Maharanas of Udaipur. Admire the craftsmanship and elegance of these vintage automobiles.
- Evening: Attend a captivating folk-dance show at Bagore ki Haveli Museum, where skilled performers showcase traditional Rajasthani dance forms such as Ghoomar and Kalbelia. Delight in the vibrant costumes, rhythmic music, and lively atmosphere that bring Rajasthan's cultural richness to life.
- Overnight stay in Udaipur.

Day 3: Udaipur - Mount Abu (165kms)

- After breakfast, check out from the hotel and embark on a scenic drive to Mount Abu, Rajasthan's hill station nestled in the Aravalli Range.
- Visit the Dilwara Temples, renowned for their stunning marble architecture and intricate carvings. These Jain temples, built between the 11th and 13th centuries, are a masterpiece of craftsmanship and spiritual devotion.
- Spend the evening relaxing by Nakki Lake, surrounded by hills and offering boating opportunities. Enjoy the serene ambiance and scenic views as you unwind.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Mount Abu.

Day 4: Mount Abu - Ahmedabad (280kms)

- After breakfast, depart for Ahmedabad, Gujarat's cultural and historical capital.
- Begin your Ahmedabad exploration with a visit to Sabarmati Ashram, Mahatma Gandhi's former residence and center of the Indian freedom struggle. Explore the ashram's museum, which displays Gandhi's personal belongings, letters, and photographs, providing insights into his life and principles of non-violence.

- Visit Adalaj Stepwell, an architectural marvel with intricate carvings and symmetrical patterns. Built in the 15th century, this stepwell served as a resting place and community center during hot summers, reflecting Gujarat's architectural heritage.

- Overnight stay in Ahmedabad.

Day 5: Ahmedabad

- After breakfast, visit Sidi Saiyyed Mosque, famous for its delicately carved stone lattice work (jalis) on the windows. Admire the intricate craftsmanship that has become an iconic symbol of Ahmedabad's architectural legacy.
- Explore Jama Masjid, an exquisite mosque built in 1424 AD with yellow sandstone and intricate carvings. Experience the spiritual ambiance and historical significance of this architectural gem.
- Optionally, visit Sarkhej Roza, a complex of tombs and pavilions showcasing Indo-Saracenic architecture and Persian influences. Wander through its serene surroundings and marvel at the architectural intricacies.
- Lunch at a local restaurant, indulging in traditional Gujarati flavors.
- Visit Calico Museum of Textiles, renowned for its extensive collection of Indian textiles and artifacts. Explore the rich history and craftsmanship of Indian textiles through exhibits of intricate weaves, embroideries, and fabrics.
- Evening: Explore the vibrant Law Garden Night Market, known for its handicrafts, jewelry, and delectable street food. Stroll through the bustling market, soaking in the lively atmosphere and shopping for souvenirs.

- Optionally, visit the Valley of Flowers, a botanical garden near the Statue of Unity showcasing indigenous flora and fauna in a natural setting.

- Dinner and overnight stay in Kevadia.

Day 7: Kevadia - Vadodara (155kms)

- After breakfast, drive to Vadodara, a city steeped in royal heritage and cultural splendor.
- Explore Laxmi Vilas Palace, an architectural masterpiece of Indo-Saracenic Revival style built by Maharaja Sayajirao Gaekwad III. Wander through its opulent interiors adorned with Belgian stained-glass windows, Venetian mosaic floors, and an extensive collection of European and Indian art.
- Visit Maharaja Fateh Singh Museum, housed within Laxmi Vilas Palace, showcasing an impressive array of paintings by Raja Ravi Varma and other eminent artists, along with royal artifacts and sculptures.
- Enjoy a leisurely evening stroll through Sayaji Baug, Vadodara's expansive public garden featuring lush greenery, a zoo, and a picturesque floral clock.
- Overnight stay in Vadodara.

Day 8: Vadodara - Departure

- After breakfast at the hotel, depending on your departure schedule, you may have some free time for last-minute shopping or exploration.
- Transfer to the airport or railway station for your onward journey, concluding your memorable tour of Udaipur, Mount Abu, Ahmedabad, Kevadia, and Vadodara.
