Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Delhi

- Arrive in Delhi and transfer to your hotel. Check-in time is 2 PM (early check-in subject to room availability). Rest and relax after your journey.

Day 2: Delhi

- Begin with breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit Jama Masjid, one of the largest mosques in India, known for its stunning architecture and panoramic views from its minarets.
- Enjoy a rickshaw ride through Chandni Chowk, a bustling market offering a wide array of goods, street food, and traditional wares.
- Explore Red Fort (Lal Qila), a UNESCO World Heritage site and a majestic fort complex showcasing Mughal architecture and historic significance. Visit the Diwan-i-Aam and Diwan-i-Khas.
- Drive past Rajpath and see Rashtrapati Bhavan (President's House), Parliament House, and India Gate, iconic symbols of India's democracy and heritage.
- Visit Humayun's Tomb, a UNESCO World Heritage site, featuring Persian-style architecture, lush gardens, and intricate mausoleums.
- Explore Qutub Minar, the tallest brick minaret in the world, built in the 12th century, with intricate carvings and inscriptions.

- Optional visit to Gurudwara Bangla Sahib, a prominent Sikh gurdwara known for its holy pond and community kitchen serving free meals.

Day 3: Delhi - Agra (210km)

- After breakfast, travel to Agra.
- Visit Itmad-ud-Daula (Baby Taj), a Mughal mausoleum known for its intricate marble inlay work.
- Early morning visit to Taj Mahal, a UNESCO World Heritage site and an architectural marvel in white marble, built by Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his wife Mumtaz Mahal. Witness the sunrise over the Taj Mahal.

Day 4: Agra - Ranthambore National Park (245kms)

- En route, visit Fatehpur Sikri, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its well-preserved Mughal architecture and historical significance.
- After checking in at the hotel, visit Ranthambore Fort, an ancient fortification offering panoramic views of the park and surrounding landscapes.
- Relax at the hotel or enjoy optional activities like nature walks or village visits.

Day 5: Ranthambore

- Early morning and afternoon jungle safaris in Ranthambore National Park for wildlife spotting, including tigers, leopards, and various bird species.
- Breakfast and lunch at the hotel.
- Optional visit to Ranthambore School of Art to see local artists' works inspired by wildlife and nature.

Day 6: Ranthambore - Bundi (150kms)

- After breakfast, drive to Bundi.
- Visit Taragarh Fort, a hilltop fortress known for its panoramic views of Bundi town and the surrounding countryside.

- Explore Bundi Palace, a majestic palace known for its Rajput architecture and murals depicting traditional Rajasthani life.
- Discover Chitrashala (Ummed Mahal), a gallery of intricate frescoes and paintings depicting scenes from mythology, history, and royal life.

Day 7: Bundi - Chittorgarh - Udaipur (265kms)

- Travel to Udaipur via Chittorgarh.
- Visit Chittorgarh Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage site and one of the largest forts in India, known for its history of heroism, sacrifice, and battles.
- Continue to Udaipur, known as the "City of Lakes" and "Venice of the East".
- Enjoy a boat ride on Lake Pichola to visit Jag Mandir Palace, set amidst the lake and offering stunning views of the City Palace complex.

Day 8: Udaipur

- Begin with breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit City Palace, a grand royal residence overlooking Lake Pichola, known for its blend of Rajput, Mughal, and European architectural styles. Explore the various courtyards, museums, and enjoy panoramic views of the lake.
- Explore Jagdish Temple, a Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu, featuring intricate carvings and sculptures.
- Visit Saheliyon ki Bari, a beautiful garden with fountains, kiosks, marble elephants, and a lotus pool.
- Optional visit to Bagore ki Haveli, a museum showcasing Rajputana culture through its display of costumes, jewelry, paintings, and artifacts.

Day 9: Udaipur - Pushkar (280kms)

- Travel to Pushkar, a sacred town known for its Brahma Temple and holy Pushkar Lake.
- Visit Brahma Temple, dedicated to Lord Brahma and one of the few temples in the world dedicated to this deity.
- Explore Pushkar Lake, considered one of the holiest lakes in India, with 52 ghats where pilgrims bathe to cleanse their sins.
- Stroll through the vibrant markets of Pushkar known for traditional handicrafts, jewelry, and spiritual souvenirs.

Day 10: Pushkar - Jaipur (145kms)

- Travel to Jaipur, the "Pink City" of Rajasthan.
- Visit Galtaji Temple, an ancient Hindu pilgrimage site with natural springs, sacred kunds (water tanks), and intricately carved pavilions.
- Visit Birla Mandir, a modern Hindu temple made of white marble, dedicated to Lord Vishnu and Goddess Lakshmi, renowned for its peaceful ambiance.
- Optional visit to Nahargarh Fort, offering stunning views of Jaipur and housing Madhavendra Bhawan, a royal residence with frescoes and scenic landscapes.
- Enjoy shopping in Jaipur for textiles, jewelry, handicrafts, and Rajasthani specialties.

Day 11: Jaipur

- Begin with breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit Amber Fort, a majestic fort complex known for its artistic Hindu-style architecture, royal palaces, and panoramic views of Maota Lake. Enjoy an elephant or jeep ride up to the fort.
- Explore City Palace, a royal residence with a blend of Rajput, Mughal, and European architectural styles, housing museums with artifacts and textiles.
- Discover Jantar Mantar, an astronomical observatory built by Maharaja Jai Singh II, featuring precise instruments for celestial measurements.
- Visit Hawa Mahal, an iconic five-story palace with honeycomb-like windows, built for royal women to observe street festivals and daily life.
- Optional visit to Albert Hall Museum, a museum showcasing artifacts, paintings, and exhibits on Rajasthan's history and culture.

Day 12: Jaipur - Mandawa (170kms)

- Travel to Mandawa, a town in the Shekhawati region known for its beautifully painted havelis (mansions).
- Visit havelis with frescoes depicting mythological scenes, historical events, and everyday life.
- Enjoy a traditional Rajasthani dinner at a heritage haveli with cultural performances.

Day 13: Mandawa - Delhi (250kms)

- Drive back to Delhi.
