Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Delhi

- Arrive at Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport and transfer to your hotel.
- Rest and relax after your journey, preparing for the adventure ahead.

Day 2: Delhi - Agra (210kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.

Day 4: Jaipur

- Breakfast at the hotel.

- Visit the City Palace complex, comprising palaces, courtyards, and museums displaying royal artifacts.
- Photo stop at the Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds), an iconic five-story palace with intricate pink sandstone carvings.

Day 5: Jaipur - Jodhpur (330kms)

Day 7: Jodhpur - Udaipur (265kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Drive to Udaipur, the "City of Lakes," known for its romantic ambiance and picturesque lakeside palaces.
- Visit the City Palace complex, overlooking Lake Pichola, showcasing Rajput and Mughal architectural styles.
- Enjoy a boat ride on Lake Pichola, visiting Jag Mandir and enjoying panoramic views of the city's skyline.

Day 8: Udaipur

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Explore the Jagdish Temple, dedicated to Lord Vishnu and known for its intricate carvings.
- Visit Saheliyon ki Bari, a royal garden adorned with fountains, kiosks, marble elephants, and a lotus pool.

Day 9: Udaipur - Mount Abu (165kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Travel to Mount Abu, Rajasthan's only hill station nestled in the Aravalli Range.
- Visit Dilwara Temples, renowned for their stunning marble architecture and intricate carvings.
- Explore Nakki Lake and enjoy leisurely walks along its scenic shores.

Day 10: Mount Abu - Ahmedabad (280kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Drive to Ahmedabad, Gujarat's largest city known for its rich cultural heritage and historic monuments.
- Visit Sabarmati Ashram, a tranquil retreat associated with Mahatma Gandhi's life and philosophy of nonviolence.
- Explore the Adalaj Stepwell, an architectural marvel showcasing Indo-Islamic design and craftsmanship.

Day 11: Ahmedabad

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit the Sidi Saiyyed Mosque, famous for its intricately carved lattice windows (jalis).

Day 12: Ahmedabad - Bhavnagar (175kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Travel to Bhavnagar, a coastal city known for its vibrant culture and historic sites.

- Visit Takhteshwar Temple, offering panoramic views of Bhavnagar from its hilltop location.
- Explore Gaurishankar Lake and Victoria Park for scenic views and tranquil surroundings.

Day 13: Bhavnagar - Junagadh (215kms)

Day 15: Sasan Gir National Park - Somnath (45kms)

- Breakfast at the hotel.

- Explore Somnath Temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva and a symbol of spiritual devotion and architectural splendor.
- Witness the evening aarti ceremony at Somnath Temple, a mesmerizing ritual on the shores of the Arabian Sea.

Day 16: Somnath - Dwarka (255kms)

- Visit Kaba Gandhi No Delo, Mahatma Gandhi's childhood home turned into a museum.
- Explore Watson Museum, showcasing artifacts and exhibits related to Rajkot's history and culture.

Day 18: Rajkot - Delhi/Mumbai

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Fly back to Delhi or Mumbai for departure, concluding your royal cities, forts, palaces, temples, and national park tour of Rajasthan and Gujarat.
