Conclude with the iconic Taj Mahal in Agra, a testament to eternal love, before bidding farewell to this regal odyssey.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Delhi

- Arrive in Delhi and transfer to your hotel. Check-in and relax after your journey.
- Begin your day with a visit to Humayun's Tomb, a UNESCO World Heritage site showcasing early Mughal architecture and lush gardens.
- Explore Safdarjung's Tomb, a late Mughal mausoleum with beautiful gardens.
- Take a stroll through Lodi Gardens, home to tombs from the Lodi dynasty, offering a peaceful retreat.
- Visit the National Museum to discover India's rich cultural heritage through artifacts ranging from prehistoric times to modern art.
- Experience the tranquility of Gurudwara Bangla Sahib, a prominent Sikh gurdwara known for its golden dome and sacred pool.
- Explore Hauz Khas Village, known for its ancient ruins, trendy boutiques, and vibrant cafes.

Day 2: Delhi - Jaisalmer (flight)

- After breakfast, fly to Jaisalmer, the "Golden City" known for its magnificent sandstone architecture.

- In the late afternoon, enjoy an excursion to Sam Sand Dunes for a camel safari amidst the vast expanse of golden sands. Enjoy a traditional barbecue dinner accompanied by folk performances under the starlit desert sky.

Day 3: Jaisalmer

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel.
- Explore Jaisalmer Fort, a living fort and UNESCO World Heritage site known for its intricate architecture, including Jain temples, havelis (traditional mansions), and narrow winding lanes bustling with life.
- Visit Patwon Ki Haveli, a cluster of five elaborately carved havelis showcasing intricate craftsmanship, frescoes depicting local legends, and ornate balconies overlooking the city.
- Discover Gadisar Lake, an artificial reservoir surrounded by temples, ghats (steps leading to the lake), and cenotaphs, offering picturesque views and glimpses of local life.

Day 4: Jaisalmer - Pokhran - Jodhpur (280kms)

- After breakfast, visit Pokhran Fort en route, known for its historical significance as a major military fortification and Rajput architecture.
- Arrive in Jodhpur and check-in to your hotel.

Day 5: Jodhpur

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel.
- Explore Mehrangarh Fort, one of Rajasthan's largest forts, offering panoramic views of Jodhpur from its ramparts. Discover its palatial courtyards, intricate carvings, and well-preserved artifacts.
- Visit Jaswant Thada, a marble cenotaph surrounded by lush gardens and intricate marble lattice work.
- Experience the vibrant atmosphere of Sardar Market and Clock Tower, known for local handicrafts, spices, textiles, and traditional Rajasthani attire.
- Explore Mandore Gardens and Museum, showcasing the history and culture of the region.

Day 6: Jodhpur - Ranakpur - Udaipur (260kms)

- After breakfast, visit the famous Jain Temple complex in Ranakpur, renowned for its exquisite marble architecture and 1444 intricately carved pillars, each with a unique design.
- Arrive in Udaipur, the "City of Lakes," and enjoy a relaxing boat ride on Lake Pichola, visiting the picturesque Jag Mandir Palace.

Day 7: Udaipur

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit City Palace, a majestic complex blending Rajasthani and Mughal architectural styles, housing royal residences, courtyards, and museums overlooking the lake.
- Explore Saheliyon Ki Bari, the "Garden of the Maidens," known for its marble pavilions, lotus pools, fountains, and lush green lawns, a serene retreat reflecting Udaipur's royal lifestyle.
- Visit the Vintage Car Museum to see a unique collection of classic cars once owned by the Maharajas of Udaipur, and Shilpgram, an arts and crafts complex showcasing traditional rural handicrafts and cultural performances.
- Optional: Visit Eklingji Temple and Nagda Temples, ancient Hindu temples known for their intricate carvings and religious significance.

Day 8: Udaipur - Jaipur (Flight)

- After breakfast, fly to Jaipur, the vibrant "Pink City."
- En route, visit Ajmer to see the revered Dargah Sharif of Moinuddin Chishti and Pushkar, known for its sacred lake and Brahma Temple.

Day 9: Jaipur

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel.
- Explore Amber Fort, a majestic hilltop fortress-palace known for its blend of Rajput and Mughal architecture, including the stunning Sheesh Mahal (Hall of Mirrors) and Ganesh Pol (Gate).
- Visit Sisodia Rani Garden, adorned with tiered gardens, fountains, and pavilions depicting scenes from Hindu mythology, providing a tranquil escape from the city bustle.

- Discover City Palace, Jaipur's royal residence featuring museums, courtyards, and the famous Chandra Mahal and Mubarak Mahal.
- Explore Jantar Mantar, an astronomical observatory and UNESCO World Heritage site, showcasing 18th-century instruments used for celestial observations.
- Visit Hawa Mahal, the iconic "Palace of Winds," known for its distinctive honeycomb facade designed to allow royal ladies to observe street festivals unnoticed.
- Immerse yourself in the vibrant markets of Johari Bazaar, Tripolia Bazaar, and Bapu Bazaar, renowned for their jewelry, textiles, handicrafts, and traditional Rajasthani artifacts.
- Visit Birla Temple, a modern Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu and Goddess Lakshmi, famous for its white marble architecture and intricate carvings.

Day 10: Jaipur - Abhaneri - Fatehpur Sikri - Agra (245kms)

- After breakfast, visit Chand Baori in Abhaneri, a stunning stepwell showcasing intricate carvings and 3,500 narrow steps.
- Explore Fatehpur Sikri, a UNESCO World Heritage site and former Mughal capital, renowned for its red sandstone architecture, palaces, and mosques.

Day 11: Agra - Delhi (210km)

- Enjoy a sunrise visit to Taj Mahal, a masterpiece of Mughal architecture and a UNESCO World Heritage site symbolizing eternal love with its white marble domes and intricate inlay work.
- Explore Agra Fort, a UNESCO site boasting palaces, mosques, and gardens, offering panoramic views of Taj Mahal from Mehtab Bagh Garden.

Day 12: Delhi - Departure (Flight)

- After breakfast, depending on your flight schedule, enjoy leisure time or indulge in last-minute shopping in Delhi before transferring to the airport for departure.
