Day 5: Jaisalmer - Jodhpur (265kms)

- Drive to Jodhpur, the Blue City.

- Arrive and transfer to your hotel.
- Explore the bustling streets of the old city, lined with vibrant markets and traditional Rajasthani eateries.
- Relax and prepare for the next day's exploration.

Day 6: Jodhpur

- Explore Mehrangarh Fort, one of India's largest forts, known for its imposing structure and museum.
- Visit Jaswant Thada, a beautiful marble cenotaph commemorating Maharaja Jaswant Singh II.

Day 8: Udaipur

- En route, make a stop to visit the Nasia Jain Temple in Ajmer, known for its intricate architecture and religious significance. Continue your journey to Pushkar, a holy town famous for the Brahma Temple and its sacred lake.
- Arrive in Jaipur and check-in at your hotel.
- In the evening, relax at your hotel and prepare for the exciting exploration awaiting you in Jaipur the next day.

Day 10: Jaipur

- Enjoy a shopping experience at Jaipur's famous markets, such as Johari Bazaar and Bapu Bazaar, renowned for textiles, jewelry, and handicrafts.

Day 11: Jaipur - Agra (245kms)

- Begin your drive to Agra, known for its iconic Taj Mahal.
- En route, visit Abhaneri to explore Chand Baori, a stunning stepwell showcasing ancient Indian engineering and carvings.
- Continue your journey to Fatehpur Sikri, an abandoned Mughal city and UNESCO World Heritage site known for its well-preserved architecture. Explore notable structures like Buland Darwaza, Jama Masjid, and the palace complexes within the fortified city.
- Proceed to Agra and check-in at your hotel.

Day 12: Agra – Delhi - Departure (204kms)

- Explore the red sandstone Agra Fort, a UNESCO site featuring palaces, mosques, and gardens.

- Visit Mehtab Bagh, a charbagh complex located on the opposite bank of the Taj Mahal. Enjoy serene views of the Taj Mahal at sunset, offering a picturesque perspective across the Yamuna River.
