Tour Overview

Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Delhi

- Arrival transfer from the airport to the hotel.
- Visit Qutub Minar, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the tallest brick minaret in the world, showcasing Indo-Islamic architecture and intricate carvings.
- Explore India Gate, a war memorial dedicated to Indian soldiers who died in World War I, and enjoy the lush green lawns and bustling atmosphere around it.
- Discover Humayun's Tomb, an architectural precursor to the Taj Mahal and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, known for its stunning Mughal architecture and beautiful gardens.

Day 2: Delhi - Prayagraj (Allahabad) (flight)

- Transfer to the airport for the flight to Prayagraj (Allahabad).

- Visit Triveni Sangam, the confluence of the Ganges, Yamuna, and Saraswati rivers, considered a sacred site for Hindu rituals and ceremonies, with devotees taking holy dips.
- Explore Anand Bhavan, the historic residence of the Nehru family, now a museum showcasing artifacts from India's independence movement, offering a glimpse into India's political history.
- Visit Allahabad Fort, a massive fort built by Emperor Akbar with significant historical and architectural value, featuring beautiful structures like the Ashoka Pillar and Saraswati Koop.

Day 3: Prayagraj - Varanasi (120kms)

- Start the day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Depart for Varanasi, one of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in the world and a major spiritual hub.
- Visit Kashi Vishwanath Temple, one of the twelve Jyotirlingas dedicated to Lord Shiva, an important pilgrimage site for Hindus, known for its spiritual significance and intricate architecture.
- Explore Sarnath, where Lord Buddha gave his first sermon after attaining enlightenment, visiting Dhamek Stupa and the Sarnath Archaeological Museum, rich with ancient Buddhist artifacts.
- Attend the evening Ganga Aarti ceremony at Dashashwamedh Ghat, a spectacular ritual of worship with lamps and chants, creating a magical atmosphere along the riverbanks.

Day 4: Varanasi

- Start the day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Early morning boat ride on the Ganges River, witnessing the mesmerizing rituals and ceremonies at the ghats, including the famous Dashashwamedh Ghat, where devotees perform daily rituals.
- Visit Bharat Mata Temple, a unique temple dedicated to Mother India, featuring a relief map of India carved in marble, symbolizing the nation's unity.
- Explore Banaras Hindu University, one of the largest residential universities in Asia, known for its picturesque campus and the Bharat Kala Bhavan Museum, housing a vast collection of art and artifacts.

- Stroll through the narrow lanes of Varanasi, discovering hidden temples, vibrant markets, and traditional crafts, offering an authentic glimpse into the city's culture and traditions.

Day 5: Varanasi - Bodhgaya (250kms)

- Start the day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Depart for Bodhgaya, the sacred place where Lord Buddha attained enlightenment under the Bodhi tree.
- Visit Mahabodhi Temple, a UNESCO World Heritage site and one of the most important Buddhist pilgrimage centers, featuring the sacred Bodhi tree and beautiful temple architecture.
- Explore the Great Buddha Statue, an impressive 80-feet tall statue symbolizing peace and spirituality, surrounded by serene gardens.
- Visit Sujata Kuti, the village where Sujata offered kheer to Buddha before his enlightenment, marking a significant event in Buddhist history, with a stupa commemorating the event.

Day 6: Bodhgaya - Deoghar (235kms)

- Start the day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Depart for Deoghar, known for its spiritual significance and serene environment.
- Visit Baidyanath Temple, one of the twelve Jyotirlingas dedicated to Lord Shiva, a major pilgrimage site for Hindus, attracting devotees from all over India.
- Explore Naulakha Mandir, a beautiful temple dedicated to Radha-Krishna, known for its unique architecture and serene ambiance.
- Visit Satsang Ashram, the spiritual center established by Sri Sri Thakur Anukulchandra, attracting devotees from around the world, offering a peaceful and reflective environment.

Day 7: Deoghar - Patna (265kms) / flight to Delhi

- Start the day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Depart for Patna, the capital city of Bihar with rich historical and cultural heritage.
- Visit Golghar, a large granary built by the British in 1786, offering panoramic views of the city from its top.

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- Explore Patna Museum, housing an impressive collection of artifacts from ancient India, including sculptures, coins, and manuscripts, showcasing Bihar's rich cultural heritage.
- Transfer to the airport for the flight to Delhi.

Day 8: Delhi - Departure

- Start the day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Depending on your flight schedule, explore more of Delhi's attractions or enjoy some last-minute shopping for souvenirs.
- Transfer to the airport for your onward journey, carrying memories of a spiritually enriching pilgrimage tour.
