Day 1: Arrive Delhi

- Visit the impressive Lotus Temple, known for its unique lotus-shaped design and peaceful ambiance, open to people of all faiths for meditation and reflection.

Day 3: Delhi - Agra (210kms)

Day 5: Ranthambore

- Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before heading out for a day of wildlife exploration.

- Visit the Mandawa Fort, an imposing structure with stunning frescoes and intricate carvings, offering a glimpse into the town's rich merchant history.
- Stroll through the town's colorful streets, discovering traditional architecture, local shops, and historical sites.

Day 9: Mandawa - Delhi (250kms)

- Drive back to Delhi, with time for last-minute shopping or exploration of the city's markets and attractions.
- Transfer to the airport for your onward journey, concluding your memorable tour through Delhi, Agra, Ranthambore, Jaipur, and Mandawa.
