Tour Overview

The tour also includes excursions to the picturesque Kada Dam and the serene forest temple of Zand Hanuman. Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Vadodara – Champaner – Jambughoda Wildlife Sanctuary (75 kms / 2 hrs)

- Morning pickup from hotel, airport, or railway station in Vadodara followed by a scenic drive towards Jambughoda Wildlife Sanctuary. The route passes through charming countryside landscapes, traditional villages, and agricultural regions of Gujarat, offering a glimpse into the rural lifestyle of the state.
- En route, visit Champaner-Pavagadh Archaeological Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site famous for its fascinating blend of Hindu and Islamic architecture. Explore ancient mosques, historic gateways, stepwells, and archaeological ruins located amidst the scenic hills of Pavagadh.
- After the heritage visit, continue driving to Jambughoda. Upon arrival, check in at the forest resort and spend time relaxing amidst the peaceful natural surroundings. The sanctuary region is known for its dense teak forests, rolling hills, rich birdlife, and wildlife species including antelopes, hyenas, wild boars, and sloth bears.
- In the evening, visit nearby tribal settlements to experience the unique traditions and lifestyle of the local indigenous communities. Interact with villagers, observe traditional homes, and learn about the customs and handicrafts preserved in this forest region. Dinner and overnight at wildlife resort in Jambughoda.

Day 2: Jambughoda Forest Excursion – Kada Dam – Zand Hanuman – Vadodara

- After breakfast at the resort, begin a guided exploration of the forest region around Jambughoda. Enjoy nature trails or forest drives through scenic landscapes filled with teak trees, small hills, and diverse bird species. The calm atmosphere and untouched surroundings make the sanctuary a wonderful destination for nature lovers and photography enthusiasts.
- Later, proceed to Kada Dam, a tranquil reservoir surrounded by forests and green hills. Spend time enjoying the fresh air, peaceful ambiance, and beautiful views of the surrounding landscape. The area becomes particularly attractive during the monsoon and winter seasons when the greenery is at its best.
- Continue exploring nearby tribal villages and rural settlements to gain deeper insight into the culture and day-to-day life of Gujarat's tribal communities. Guests may also enjoy optional activities such as birdwatching, village walks, or photography in the natural surroundings.
- Afterward, check out from the resort and visit Zand Hanuman, a sacred temple site located amidst forested surroundings and visited by local devotees throughout the year. The peaceful atmosphere and scenic location add a spiritual touch to the journey.
- Later, drive back to Vadodara and transfer to hotel, airport, or railway station for onward journey.
